#### THANKSGIVING GAMES OVERVIEW

The Thanksgiving season is busy with lots of quests and a couple of locations.

Your first challenge is **NOT** to open the Turkey House. You should complete all the Part 1 quests first. These are all the quests before opening the Turkey House.

AND you will need to have the Turkey House open before you work on Pilgrim Theater, as the quests will have you searching the Turkey House.

Part 1 for the Thanksgiving House is easily completed for even low level players. The challenge will be getting enough trading items. As with all other quests in this game, you'll need to do lots of searching to build up your trading weapons. Many characters have multiple lives.

Once you complete the Part 1 quests opening the Turkey House should be quite easy. The challenge, as usual, is obtaining the search keys in order to complete the Part 2 quests.

(See separate file for Thanksgiving Street Patrol) You should be stocking up on your Sling Shots and First Aid Kits because you will need a lot of them to get through all the levels. While challenging, the rewards are great. There is a file to guide you on the blog under Street Patrol.

It will come with a Right Side Medal (Cornucopias) Challenge to earn Legendary Chests.

There will be 9 Right side game quests. You won't get them all at once. As you finish one a new one will pop up.

There are many new characters in the game, so it may be a bit confusing at the start.
