Dab, hash oil, honey oil, wax, 710, budder, shatter, are just some of the slang names for marijuana concentrates. These concentrates, in which the highly potent THC (Tetrahydrocannabinol) is extracted from the plant, are an oil or wax-like substance that resembles honey or butter and has THC levels ranging from 40-80%. E-cigarettes or vaporizers are often used to ingest these concentrates. The user takes a "dab" (small amount of the concentrate) and then heats it using an e-cigarette or vaporizer producing vapors

that provide an instant high

People also line their masks with Vicks VapoRub, or METH to enhance their rolls. So banning face masks seems to have been designed as a deterrent to that kind



of drug-centric activity. But these days, there are plenty of party people who wear masks for fashion's sake alone. Maybe that's why we never heard a raver complain about confiscations or being stopped for wearing one. Pacifier: for involuntary teeth grinding and clenching.

**Stuffed Animals** This rule is also a crackdown on the childish accessories associated with rave's drug culture. ALCOHOLIC DRINKS Four Loko, Twisted Tea, Sparks Blackberry are just a few of the flavored alcohol beverages whose packages may be appealing to teens and are frequently made with a high alcohol content and caffeine. One can of Four Loko has the alcohol content equivalent to approximately 4.5 cans of beer.

Purple Drank is a slang term for a mixture of a prescription cold medication, a soda drink and ice. Hard candies are often added for color and taste. The cold medication used contains promethazine (an antihistamine) and codeine. The effects of this drink last between three and six hours. In addition, in some communities, other homemade drink concoctions called "nutcrackers" are also popular among teens and youth. Double cup. Two

cups stacked on each other, filled to the brim with a cocktail consisting of promethazine and codeine syrup, candy (usually Jolly Ranchers, or Skittles), ice, and a soft drink of choice (Sprite, Fanta, etc.) "Po'up in my double cup."
