

GAME – *Guessing Game*

In this game, students must describe someone without using their name. Students are limited to three sentences, with each sentence worth less points. If the student uses a relative pronoun (like **who, whose, which**) in a sentence, they will receive a bonus point.

This game is played in two ways.

1. The first way is to have students describe a famous celebrity. It might be easier to begin by writing a list of famous celebrities known to the students on the board. This way, there are fewer possibilities for who it could be.
2. The second way is for students to describe other students, tutors, or teachers in the room.

Ex. She is a woman from New York. (9 points)

She is somebody who was married to Marc Anthony. (6 points +1 bonus point)

She is famous for her nickname, which is Jenny from the Block. (3 points +1 bonus point)

Answer: Jennifer Lopez!
