

Our staff leadership team has been meeting during the summer to make plans for the upcoming school year. At the summer leadership meetings, the team worked on all aspects of Westbrook. We finalized scheduling, analyzed data, refreshed our Westbrook vision, mission, and purpose, implemented MCPS initiatives, revised and updated daily procedures, and had professional development to enhance our capacity to provide an anti-racist, anti-biased environment for all our students. All staff has participated in at least two days over the summer for the new English Language Arts curriculum adopted by MCPS. We are thrilled to be in a place where we can integrate the Science of Reading framework using the CKLA curriculum from Amplify. There will be some changes in our teaching practices in all ELA classrooms as we enhance the educational opportunity for our students and provide intentional intervention and enrichment based on achievement data. This is an exciting time! We are committed to ensuring everyone's inclusiveness and acceptance. Through social-emotional learning and deepening our understanding of ourselves and others, we will continue to build on kindness, acceptance, and inclusion. Westbrook welcomes everyone!

Additionally, we expanded our work on the School Improvement Plan (SIP) with specific goals for various subgroups of students in reading, math, student well-being, and climate and culture. We are excited to continue to gain your thoughts and input as well. Your partnership and voice matter. Westbrook Elementary School's anticipated enrollment for the upcoming school year is 460 students. We plan to have three kindergarten classes, three first-grade classes, four second-grade classes, three third-grade classes, three fourth-grade classes, and four fifth-grade classes. The start and end times of the school day remain the same as last year. Doors open at 8:50 am. Students will be considered tardy after 9:00 am unless due to a bus issue. Dismissal will begin at 3:20 pm. For early release days, dismissal will occur at 12:55 pm.

If your student takes the bus to or from school, please review the FY25 <u>bus routes and schedule</u>. Please arrive at the bus stop at least 5 minutes before departure. Parents are responsible for their child on the way to the bus stop, at the bus stop, and on the way home from the bus stop. Please arrange for a caregiver or responsible adult to meet your student at the bus stop and ensure their safety. You can find more bus expectations on the <u>parent dashboard</u> under transportation.

The school year starts on Monday, August 26, and we will have our annual Open House on Friday, August 23, from 2 to 3 p.m. When attending our Open House and other school functions, please respect the neighborhood and do not park in prohibited locations.

As we start the school year, I want to remind you that Westbrook is a place that welcomes all! We are a school that is inclusive to all in our community, no matter one's race, gender, beliefs, needs, or sexual orientation. As determined by MCPS, there is no notification of materials used for instruction to the community, nor is there any opt-out policy for instruction, except for the fifth grade Family Life Curriculum in the Spring. Fifth Grade families will be invited to a meeting in late February on this topic. We will provide a diverse, inclusive, and rigorous curriculum to all our students in the year ahead!
