HOW TO REPORT STINKNET

If you think you see stinknet → Go to www.stinknet.org where you will find photos and other information to help you decide. If you have stinknet, please help us by reporting it. If you don't have a cell signal, you can take the photo and then report later.

If you are in southern Arizona → Report your siting to www.stinknet.org. This site uses Survey123. Downloading the Survey 123 app is free. Reporting uses an interactive menu and map. In addition to your name and contact information, you will fill in some blanks (most have answers to choose):

Estimate the number of plants

About how big is the population?

Photo of the plants

Landowner (Optional)

Landowner contact (optional)

Did you pull/treat the plants?

If you are NOT in southern Arizona → Report your siting to www.INaturalist.org or to www.EddMaps.org. Both will require you to set up a username and password to make a report. If you anticipate using these, sign up before you head out so that you are ready. They ask for similar information as above and offer you a place to upload your photo. These apps work across the U.S.

Reporting stinknet helps land managers manage the threat by early detection and intervention. Once stinknet is widespread in an area, control is expensive and requires chemical application and repeat visits over several years.
