Identification Bracelets

A transition concern may be having the proper identification on your young adult at all times. They may not always have their cell phone, purse, or wallet on them when they happen to get lost or in an emergency situation. One way to identify your young adult quickly and safely is for them to wear an ID bracelet **every day.** The bracelet may also be a medical bracelet if necessary. Some of the information that can be placed on it aside from **Name, Address, and Cell #** is a **medical diagnosis** such as Autism Spectrum Disorder, Epilepsy, Asthma, Diabetic, Allergies, etc.

Some of the bracelets can be left on 24/7 and some have clasps that are very difficult to get off. This may be helpful for some of our young adults.


