What will I learn?

This new course is a practical programme where you will perform an acting and production role for a live production. This provides a natural progression into NCEA Level 1, 2 and 3 Drama, Music and Dance Achievement Standards. During this course, you will learn the skills needed in Dance, Drama and Music to perform a role in a range of scenes and a mini production. You will explore a range of theatre forms including Musical Theatre and New Zealand Theatre, as well as explore the ins and outs of backstage, costume design, make-up, sound and lighting.

Year 9 Drama/Music AND/OR Year 10 Drama/Dance/Music is recommended but not required
