

# Uniform Guide 2025/2026

## **Requirements for All Students**

- K-8th new white logos will be required on polos starting 2024/2025.
- Logos are not required on Mass day oxfords.
- New logos on outerwear such as sweatshirts, jackets, sweaters and middle school blazers will be required starting 2025/2026.
- Little Flower Academy Pre-K logos are being retired for the 2026/27 school year and Pre-K will wear standard STCS logos on uniforms. Pre-K3 will not need Mass Uniforms.

# Grooming & accessories

- Uniforms should be well-fitted, clean, in good repair, and wrinkle-free.
- Uniform shirts should be tucked in at all times.
- Pants, shorts, skirts, and skorts should be worn at the waist. Boys (grades 1-8) must wear belts when pants or shorts have belt loops.
- Skirts, skorts, and shorts should not be shorter than fingertip length on thighs.
  This includes the shortest part of the skirt (if there is a slit).
- Makeup is not allowed for grades PK-5th grade. Girls in Middle School (Grades 6-8), are allowed to wear concealer and a natural foundation. Eye makeup, blush, and tinted lip products are not allowed. Administration is the final authority of what is appropriate.
- Hair should be clean, groomed, and not distracting. Hairstyles should be conservative in nature, to include no bleaching or coloring of hair. Boys' hair may not extend below the shirt collar or cover eyes. No facial hair.
- Drawing on skin, including tattoos, body/hair glitter, ink, etc. on any visible body parts is not permitted.
- Jewelry: Students may wear a small religious necklace, one unobtrusive bracelet or watch (without Wi-Fi connectivity or games), and one ring. Girls may wear

- one pair of post earrings, not to extend beyond the earlobes (no hoops or dangling earrings).
- o Hair accessories: Headbands, bows, barrettes and hair ties are allowed and must be navy, red, white or black. Elaborate accessories are not permitted.
- Fingernails should be kept short and clean. Nail polish is not allowed for grades PK-7th grade.
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade privilege only: Girls in 8th grade may wear nail polish on their natural nails (no false nails). Shades of reds, pinks and nudes (including french manicures) are allowed. No multicolor, glitter or nail art is allowed.

### • Shoes & socks

- Shoes must be mostly black, white, or gray athletic shoes with solid black or white shoelaces. Accents are allowed, but no patterns or ornaments.
- Socks must be solid black, white, gray, or navy. Black, white, red, or navy accents are allowed, but no patterns or ornaments.
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade privilege only: Boys may wear any color socks, including patterns and graphic images. Girls may also wear any color socks, including patterns and graphic images OR they may wear nail polish on their natural nails (no false nails), but <u>not</u> both. They are only allowed one 8th grade privilege. Shades of reds, pinks and nudes (including french manicures) are allowed. No multicolor, glitter or nail art is allowed.

# Layered Clothing

# School-approved Indoor Wear - school logo required

- Navy hooded pullover or full-zip sweatshirt with school emblem (all grades).
  Middle school students may wear red hoodies. Hooded pullovers may NOT be worn during Mass. Navy school-approved indoor wear/layered clothing without hoods is acceptable during Mass. Middle School students may only wear blazers as outwear all day during Mass day.
- o Outerwear must be appropriately worn or kept in student backpacks/lockers. Outerwear can only be tied around the waist during lunch, recess, and PE (with teacher permission).

## Spirit Day

Spirit Days are announced through the school communication portals.

- o Everyday uniform can still be worn on Spirit Days.
- Any STCS or St. Theresa Parish-issued shirt. Middle school shorts or sweats may be worn.
- Black, navy, blue denim, or khaki pants, capris, shorts, or skirts that must be no shorter than fingertip length on thighs; this length requirement pertains to potential slits in skirts or shorts.
- Clothing must not be altered or defaced. No torn or cut jeans. No leggings unless worn under shorts or skirts.
- o Spirit passes may not be used for mass days. Students are expected to wear their designated uniform for school mass.

## Special School Dress Events

## STCS Uniform Guide (25-26)

- Students will wear appropriate clothing, depending on the casual or formal theme of the event. Modest attire is required. No spaghetti-strap, strapless, backless, or cutouts.
- o Clothing must not be altered or defaced. No torn or cut jeans. No leggings unless worn under shorts or skirt.
- o Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than fingertip length on thighs.

## Girls PK3/PK4

# Everyday uniform

- o Red polo dress with logo. Undershort (bike short) must be worn and not visible.
- o Undershort acceptable colors: solid red, black, gray, or navy.
- o Mostly black or mostly white athletic shoes with velcro or stretch lace closures (no tie shoelaces or lights.)
- Mass uniform (worn on Mass days starting on the first Mass in October)
  - Plaid jumper
  - Collared shirt with red piping
  - o Solid black or navy undershorts must be worn and not visible.
  - Mostly black or mostly white athletic shoes with velcro or stretch lace closures (no tie shoelaces or lights.)
- Cold weather option: navy or black tights or leggings can be worn under uniform

## Boys PK3/PK4

- Everyday uniform
  - Red polo shirt with logo
  - Full Elastic waisted Khaki shorts or pants (no belts, belt loops, or zippers, please)
  - o Mostly black or mostly white athletic shoes with velcro or stretch lace closures (no tie shoelaces or lights.)
- Mass uniform (worn on Mass days starting on the first Mass in October)
  - White short or long-sleeved Oxford shirt (logo optional).
  - Plaid tie
  - Full elastic waisted khaki pants
  - o Mostly black or mostly white athletic shoes with velcro or stretch lace closures (no tie shoelaces or lights.)

## Girls K-3rd grades

- Everyday uniform
  - Navy polo shirt with logo.
  - o Plaid skort or skirt.
- Mass uniform (worn on Mass days starting on the first Mass in October)
  - Collared shirt with red piping
  - Red cross tie
  - Plaid jumper

- Solid black or navy undershorts must be worn and not visible.
- Cold weather option: navy or black tights or leggings worn under uniforms.

# **Boys K-3rd grades**

- Everyday uniform
  - Navy polo with logo.
  - Khaki shorts or pants.
  - o Brown leather belt (for 1st-3rd grades only)
- Mass uniform (worn on Mass days starting on the first Mass in October)
  - White short or long-sleeved Oxford shirt (logo optional).
  - Plaid tie
  - Khaki pants
  - o Brown leather belt (for 1st-3rd grades only)

## Girls 4th-5th grades

- Everyday uniform
  - Red polo with logo
  - Plaid skort or skirt.
- Mass uniform (worn on Mass days starting on the first Mass in October)
  - White girls' Oxford shirt
  - Red cross tie
  - Plaid skort or skirt.
  - Solid black or navy shorts must be worn under skirt
- Cold weather option: navy or black tights or leggings worn under uniform.

# Boys 4th-5th grades

- Everyday uniform
  - Red polo with logo
  - Khaki shorts or pants
  - Brown leather belt
- Mass uniform (worn on Mass days starting on the first Mass in October)
  - White short or long-sleeved Oxford shirt (logo optional)
  - o Plaid tie
  - Khaki pants
  - o Brown leather belt

## Girls 6th-8th grades

- Everyday uniform
  - Red polo with logo
  - o Plaid skort or skirt.
- Mass uniform (worn on Mass days starting on the first Mass in October)
  - White girls' Oxford shirt
  - Red cross tie

#### STCS Uniform Guide (25-26)

- Plaid skirt
- Solid black or navy shorts must be worn under skirt
- Navy blazer with logo
- Cold weather option: navy or black tights or leggings underneath uniform.

# Boys 6th-8th grades

- Everyday uniform
  - o Red polo with logo
  - Khaki shorts or pants
  - Brown leather belt
- Mass uniform (worn on Mass days starting on the first Mass in October)
  - White short or long-sleeved Oxford shirt (logo optional)
  - o Plaid tie
  - Khaki pants
  - Brown leather belt
  - Navy blazer with logo

#### Grades 6th-8th P.E. Uniform

- Dry weave t-shirt and shorts or sweats with STCS logo from Dennis. Leggings may be worn under shorts for cold weather.
- Refer to grade-level information sheets for specific P.E. days to wear P.E. uniform.
