



AniManGaki: Enter At Your Own Risk ft. Genshin Impact Varsity Challenge Points System Guide

University student travellers, here's how you and your team accumulate the points to win this challenge!

For this activity, the definition of all terms are as follows:

- **RANK:** Your placement against other entries (varsity contestants) based on the SCORE from our judges and/or likes from the public.
- **SCORE:** The number given by our judges for each entry
- **POINTS:** The amount you receive based on your RANK against other varsity entries.

- 1) FIND A REP FOR EACH COMPETITION & ENTER AS A TEAM OF THREE
It is important that each of your three team members represents your team for each of the competitions (Art, No Budget Cosplay, Geek Chef). Two team members cannot join the same competition. To qualify as a team, all team members must submit a working entry into each of the competitions. Should one team member fail to submit their entries, the team is disqualified.
- 2) THE HIGHER YOU RANK, THE MORE THE POINTS YOU COLLECT
After each competition ends, all entries will be graded by judges and will be uploaded online for public voting. With the SCORE and number of likes, your entries will be RANKed to determine your POINTS. You will obtain two POINTS for each competition, one based on your RANKing from the judges' SCOREs and one based on your RANKing from the public voting. The winners are determined by totalling both POINTS for all three competitions.

In the event, should there be a total POINTS tie between any of the top 3 teams, our event sponsor(s) will decide on which team has the best overall entries as a bonus point.

For Example

To illustrate the POINT SYSTEM,

The ranking below is based on **12 qualified teams**. If there are more teams or lesser teams, the amount of points will be adjusted accordingly (e.g., if there are 10 qualified teams, the maximum points for ranking 1st in any category will be 10 points only) :

Let's say your team ranks like so:

Your team's total score would be **47 POINTS**. So the more points you collect, the better your odds are at winning against other teams.

TLDR Version

To qualify for the Varsity Challenge, you must

- 1) Form a team of three and register your team
- 2) Each team member joins one competition each
- 3) Submit entries by deadline
- 4) Wait for the winner announcement during the livestream on Nov 12 @ 9pm.
