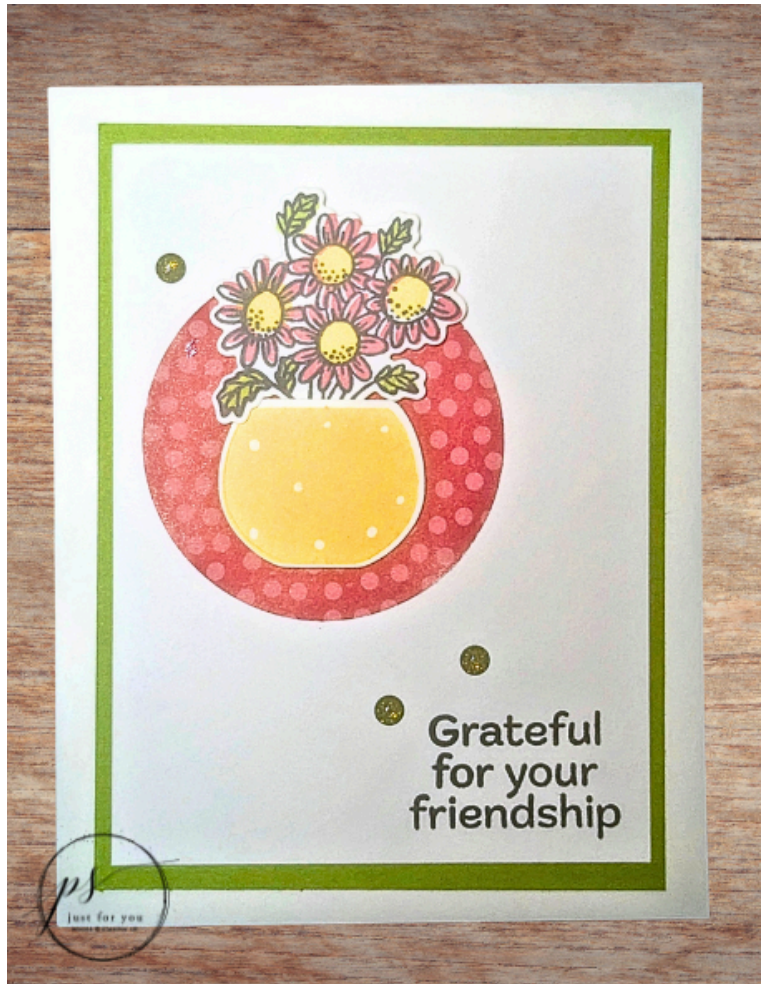


# Pop-Up Petals



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## **Supplies:**

- Stamp Sets: Pop-Up Petals (167041)
- Cardstock and Paper: Thick Basic White (159229); Basic White (166780); Granny Apple Green (146990); Hand Made with Love 12"x12" Designer Series Paper (167054)
- Stampin' Ink: Daffodil Delight Classic Pad (147094) Strawberry Slush Classic Pad (165286); Tuxedo Black Memento Pad (132708); Stampin' Blends Combo Pack Granny Apple Green (154885)
- Miscellaneous: Pop-Up Petals Dies (167043); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Bone Folder (102300); 2 3/8" Circle Punch; Low-Profile Sparkle Dots (166157)

## **Measurements:**

- Thick Basic White Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4", folded and burnished with the Bone Folder

- Granny Apple Green Cardstock: 3 ¾" x 5"
- Regular Basic White Cardstock: 3 ½" x 5"; medium scrap
- Designer Series Paper: polka dot design – 1 ½" x 5 ½", diagonal design – 2 pieces ½" x 5 ½", 2 3/8" circle- punched

**Instructions:**

1. Adhere the Granny Apple Green cardstock to the front of the card base.
2. Using the Memento ink, stamp the sentiment in the lower right corner of the 3 ½" x 4 ¾" Basic White and adhere to the Granny Apple Green piece.
3. Adhere the DSP circle to the Basic White layer, towards the left edge.
4. Using the Memento ink, stamp the bunch of flowers onto the scrap of Basic White. Use Strawberry Slush to stamp the petals of the flowers and the Daffodil Delight to stamp the centers.
5. Use the Daffodile Delight ink to stamp the vase onto the same piece of scrap Basic White.
6. Cut out with the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine and the Pop-Up Petals Dies, the bunch of flowers and the vase.
7. Using Stampin' Dimensionals, adhere the flowers and vase onto the DSP circle.
8. Place three of the green Low-Profile Dots to the card.
