## Welcome to 6<sup>th</sup> Grade! Grade 6 Supply List: 2026-2027

### \*Important Notes:

- Please keep in mind that students will carry their backpacks from class to class, therefore, no "Rolling Backpacks" are allowed.
- Please do not bring white-out (liquid or tape).
- **Please note: Notebooks and certain supplies will be left in the classroom (i.e. marble notebooks, HMH textbooks, etc.)**

### General school supplies for all subjects include:

- 1 container disinfectant wipes
