Students will be expected to bring in materials from their classes each day to work on during group instruction and independent learning. Each class will begin with a review of upcoming assignments posted on Google Classroom, followed by completing your assignment log.

- To create a structured space to work on homework/classwork
- To foster study skills
- To increase organization and time management
- To help build positive relationships with peers and school staff
- To create and reflect on school goals
