Automatically Upload Photos from your iPad to Google Photos



- 1. Open the Google Drive app on your iPad.
- 2. Make sure you are signed in with your district email and password.



- 3. Click the menu button at the top left corner.
- 4. Click on Settings.
- 5. Click on Photos.
- 6. Turn on Google Photos folder if it is not already on.
- 7. Turn on Auto Backup.
- 8. Your photos will start to upload as long as you are connected to Wifi.
- 9. It may take a while for all your photos to upload if you have a lot of them.
- 10. Once you are sure your photos have uploaded to Google Drive, you can delete your photos from your camera.
- 11. When you need to access your photos, go to Google Drive and click on the menu button at the top left corner. Then click on Google Photos.
