

Automatically Upload Photos from your iPad to Google Photos



1. Open the Google Drive app on your iPad.
2. Make sure you are signed in with your district email and password.



3. Click the menu button at the top left corner.
4. Click on Settings.
5. Click on Photos.
6. Turn on Google Photos folder if it is not already on.
7. Turn on Auto Backup.
8. Your photos will start to upload as long as you are connected to Wifi.
9. It may take a while for all your photos to upload if you have a lot of them.
10. Once you are sure your photos have uploaded to Google Drive, you can delete your photos from your camera.
11. When you need to access your photos, go to Google Drive and click on the menu button at the top left corner. Then click on Google Photos.
