There are limited parking spaces on the grass in front of the indoor arena. There is plenty of gravel parking to the left when you pull in.

All Hunter classes will be judged on performance; including way of going, jumping style and soundness. Manners and suitability will be emphasized in Pony, Children's and Adult Amateur Hunter classes.

You may join or renew your BHSA and/or your VHSA Memberships. Please be prepared to pay with a check. Cash will not be accepted.

DIRECTIONS

From Northern VA: 95 South to Exit 130 B (Rt. 3 West). Go six traffic lights to a left on Salem Church Rd. (Rt. 639). Continue to Harrison Rd. (Rt. 620). Turn Left onto Harrison Rd. Go approximately ½ Mile to Hazelwild Farm on the left.

From Richmond: 95 North to exit 126. Take Rt. 1 North off exit to Rt. 620 (Harrison Rd.). Turn left on Harrison Rd. Continue approximately 1 mile and cross over I-95. Hazelwild Farm is the first turn on the right.

From Southern MD: Take U.S. 301 South across Potomac River. Turn right on Rt. 206 towards King George. Turn right on Rt. 3 West. Continue about 30 miles to Rt. 1. Follow Rt. 1 South to Rt. 620 (Harrison Rd.). Turn right on Harrison Rd. Go approximately 1 mile, cross over I-95. Hazelwild Farm in the first turn on the right.

From Warrenton: Take 17 South to 95 South. Go one exit to 130 B. Follow Northern VA directions above.

From Culpeper: Take Rt. 3 East to Rt. 620 (Harrison Rd.). Turn right onto Harrison Rd. Continue approximately 4 miles to Hazelwild Farm on the left.

Open to juniors on horses or ponies, and adult amateurs on horses or ponies not entered in a pony division. To be shown at walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. Test 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. *May be split: Juniors(14&under), Juniors(15-17), and Adults, if entries warrant.

Open to horses and ponies ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. An Adult Amateur can ride a pony if the pony is not competing in a pony class or division. These riders are not eligible for AA Equitation, Pony Equitation, or Jr./Children's Equitation. Horses and ponies may cross enter into other divisions.

Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences: 2'0" or 2'3".

Aunt Sis Memorial Classic Junior / Amateur 2', 2'6" or 3' Sponsored by Hazelwild Farm

Open to Jr's on horses or ponies and AA on horses or ponies not entered in a pony division who will jump two rounds that will be scored numerically and will be combined for a final score. The top eight will be called back for the second round. Ribbons will be given through 6th place.

SHOW RULES

1. **ASTM/SEI certified helmets must be worn by ALL RIDERS when mounted.** Proper attire is required. Jackets may be excused by the judge.
2. Class Specification – Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current BHSA and VHSA rule book, will be conducted and judged accordingly. The judge's decision is always final.
3. All exhibitors must be checked in at the in gate when their class is called.
4. Pre-entries are \$18.00 per class. Post entries \$25.00 per class. Non Showing fee of \$25.00 for the day. Aunt Sis Classic is \$25
5. Entries will not be accepted without the release form signed.
6. All ages are as of December 1, 2025.
7. All horses/ponies on show grounds must present a negative coggins test taken within one year for each entry at each horse show. We will not keep coggins on file any longer. **Please email a copy with an entry form.**
8. **Entries must leave completed payment before leaving show grounds. \$50.00 will be charged for returned checks. If you plan to pay in cash, please bring exact change. No change will be given.**
9. Points will be awarded using the VHSA/BHSA bonus point system.
10. Show management reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel and/or combine classes if necessary.
11. Exhibitors show at their own risk.
12. Dogs must be kept under control and confined or leashed at all times.
13. Lunging is permitted only in the ring near the entrance to the farm. Schooling will be allowed in the ring at designated times. Show management reserves the right to split or to terminate schooling. Please see Facebook for the time table.
14. Food will be available on the grounds.
15. Hazelwild Farm Educational Foundation, any officials, and employees related to the foundation, and its board of directors, will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, property, or animal at the show.
16. Participants and spectators alike understand that horses are inherently unpredictable and dangerous and that equipment and ground conditions are equally unpredictable; and knowingly choose to participate and/or spectate, taking full responsibility for this choice. Entry onto the grounds constitutes knowledge and agreement with this policy.

Aunt Sis Memorial Classic Show Rules

- *All are invited to show. However, riders must be a member of a team listed on the entry form to be eligible for prize money.
- *Teams by September 2 2026. Email entries to hazelwildfarm1897@gmail.com.
- *Riders can only be one team. A team must consist of no less than four and no more than six riders. Only the top 4 rider's points will count towards the team.
- *Horses/Ponies can be on multiple teams.
- *Teams are required to pre-enter. Individuals not on a team may enter on show day at the post entry price. Payment is due on show day.
- *No changes to teams accepted after 8:00 am on show day.
- *A team member may do a division on one horse and the second division on a different horse. This must be designated on the team entry.
- *Team points will only be accepted from two divisions per team member designated on the pre-entry form. Only the top 4 rider's points will count towards the team. The Aunt Sis Classic will count in addition to your two divisions.
- *Only one professional is allowed per team.
- *On the pre-entry form, team members must write in the divisions to count towards team points.
- *Points are calculated using the current BHSA/VHSA point system.
- *A high point award and a reserve high point award will be presented to the team accumulating the most points for the day.
- *In case of a tie, one rider from each team will compete in a jump-off. Fences in the jump off will be no higher than 2'6".
- *This event is to promote sportsmanship and teamwork. Anyone not exhibiting sportsmanlike behavior will be asked to leave and forfeit all entries.
- *If you wish to challenge the team awards you must do so in person, day of the show.
- *Points from this show **WILL** count towards Hazelwild Farm year end awards. The Hazelwild Farm Show Series dates are 12/14/25
1/18/26, 2/28/26, 3/8/26, 4/19/26, 5/17/26, 6/13/26, 7/18/26, 8/23/26, 9/5/26, 10/19/26
Year end awards will be presented at the October 19th show.

Horse Show Procedures

- Pre entries are due the Wednesday before the show at noon.
- To enter go to www.RingRadar.com and search for the show
- Pre-entries are \$18/class, \$25/Aunt Sis Classic.
- There is a \$10 office fee for each rider/horse combination.
- Entries will not be considered complete until you have entered through ringradar and sent a valid coggins to hazelwildfarm1897@gmail.com
- You must also sign a waiver/release form. This will be sent to you via an email after you enter the show. Entries made after Noon the Wednesday before the show will be \$25/class.
- You can enter in Ring Radar up to 5pm the day before the show. After 5pm the day before the show you will need to see the secretary at the show Each individual must check out at the secretary stand before leaving the farm
- We accept checks (payable to Hazelwild Farm), exact change cash and in Ring Radar you can pay by card (4% processing fee).

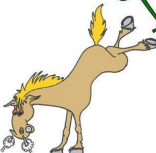

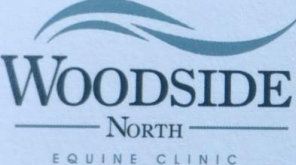
