

# Privacy Statement

Statement on the collection, storage, and use of personal information: Section 1: information collected The organising committee, composed of staff members from ScholarOne and Cornucopia, (hereafter referred to as "we"), will collect personal information for the purposes of this competition. The information collected will be as follows:

- Discord Username of the participant
- School Name of the participant
- Real Name of the participant
- Time Zone of the participant
- City of residence of the participant

Section 2: Storage of personal information: The aforementioned information will be stored from the date of collection until April 3rd, unless unforeseen circumstances force us to extend the mock round.

Section 3: Usage of personal information The aforementioned information (excluding the participant's discord username), *will not* be made public. The aforementioned information will be used to verify participant eligibility and to avoid certain inconveniences during the competition, including but not limited to:

- Ensuring compatible time zones for debate
- To prevent same-school debates
- To prevent debates from being adjudicated by adjudicators from the same school

By participating in this competition, you agree to the collection and processing of your personal information in accordance with the aforementioned terms. We reserve all rights to modify this document and the terms within at any point before, during and after the competition.

# Participation Terms and Conditions

If you are unable to participate in the live Mock Bowl or are unable to find any suitable times to do the Mock Debate, Writing or Challenge, then you will forfeit your chance to obtain any awards in those events as well as any points from those events, which has a risk of severely hampering your overall individual and team score.

By participating in the Scholar's Challenge you agree to NOT share the files with any other scholar until the mock round is completed, and you agree to NOT cheat on the scholar's challenge in any way that you would NOT do in the real scholar's challenge

By participating in the Mock Debates you agree to NOT use any form of external notes, information, AI or communication systems besides those necessary for the usage of the debate.

If the ScholarOne staff or the Cornucopia staff believe you to have utilised AI in any form or way in your submitted piece for the Writing, there is a high risk of being disqualified from awards for Writing

By registering to adjudicate debates, you agree to NOT share the debate motions you are entrusted with to the debaters you are adjudicating NOR any other people (not just scholars participating in this mock round). If you are found violating this agreement you will be banned from participating in any mock rounds hosted by either S1 or Cornucopia as well as having the debate scores you have already written being rendered null.

By registering to adjudicate debates, you accept that you will not be able to participate in the Debate event in the S1/C Mock Round I, nor will your teammates be able to participate, which may severely affect your score. Hence, it is highly recommended that only retired scholars and coaches choose to adjudicate, or if you plan to adjudicate then please inform your teammates beforehand and obtain their agreement.
