Before Thanksgiving Break, students will switch to the Trigger trombone. When it is time to switch, Mr. Ward will communicate with families and facilitate exchanging the trombone out for the new one. All money spent on the Non-Trigger trombone will be applied to the Trigger trombone. This means you MUST rent or buy from one of our Music Stores - Strait Music or Band Connection.
