The Women's Social Club of Kent Ohio is composed of African American women from Kent and the surrounding Kent community. The club has been in existence for sixty years. The Women's Social Club of Kent seeks to provide social opportunities, contribute to philanthropic needs, and encourage minority high school graduates to pursue higher education. Each year the club awards an annual scholarship of at least \$500 to a selected, deserving graduating Roosevelt High School student.

Those students applying for the Women's Social Club of Kent Scholarship should meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled, attend, and be listed in the current graduating class of Theodore Roosevelt High School in Kent, OH.
- Be a senior student in good academic and behavioral standing
- Be eligible and scheduled for the 2025 Roosevelt graduation
- Must have confirmed and verifiable plans for higher education after completion of graduation
- Have a strong academic background with a minimum cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher
- Extra-curricular or co-curricular involvement achievement, community involvement, as well as a record of demonstrated support, and/or contributions to the African-American school or local community
