IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

- Ensure Self-Safe
- Ensure no others are in danger
- All paddlers stop, meet
- Dr. Green will assume responsibility if present unless he is disabled. If he is not present, the closest certified or trained river leader will assign a command person.
- Treat ABCs (airway-breathing-circulation)
- Activate EMS - Dial 911 if signal, otherwise activate SOS on Garmin InReach Mini (trip leader carries one)
- Clear spine, extract victim or send two paddlers to meet EMS in the event that victim cannot be moved
- Group maintenance

MAP OF RIVER AND SURROUNDINGS & DESCRIPTION

A unique little run in the interface of the prairies and foothills of Southern Alberta. This run is characterized by a few small ledges near the beginning and then loads of great eddies, little surf waves and fun 'boogie water'. Really a Class II+ run, (note, at flood, it can get into the Class III range, which is outside of our BDP scope).

Off-water risks include inclement weather, slippery rock, uneven pathways, and slippery mud at the put-in and take-outs. On-water risks include fishermen, extremely cold water/hypothermia, swift-moving water, foot entrapment, wood, and shallow and rocky areas.

There is no accessible AED or first aid kit on this run beyond what paddlers bring with them. The closest hospital is 1222 Bev McLachlin Dr, Pincher Creek, AB T0K 1W0, ~15-20 min drive from the put-in/take-out..

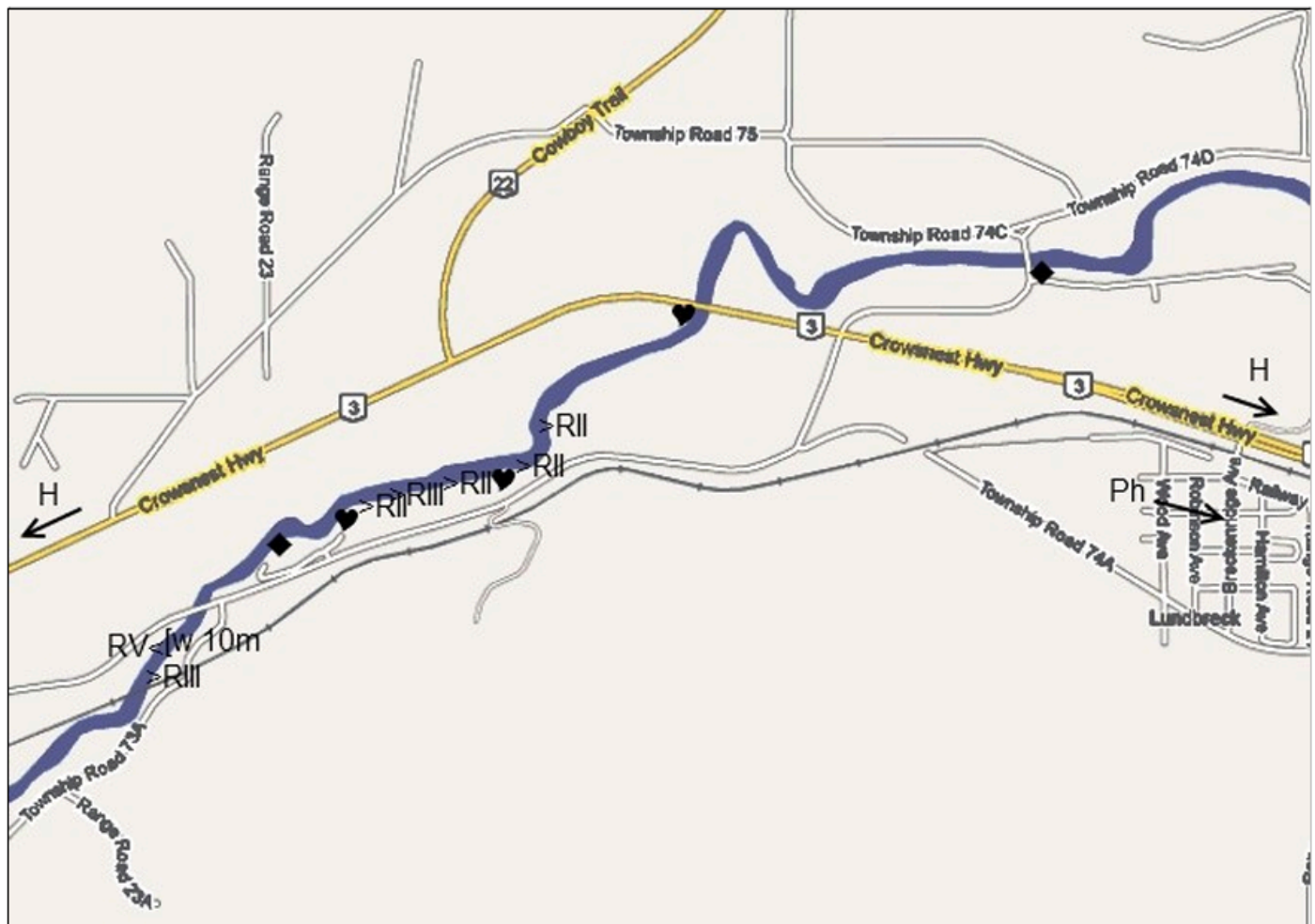

DIRECTIONS

Put in either below Lundbreck Falls on river left (and find parking in the busy viewpoint area on river right and left), or put in at the Lundbreck campground a little further downstream. To get to the campground from Lundbreck take Hwy 3 west and turn left at the bottom of the first hill on to 3A. Follow road up and around until you see the campground, roughly 2km. Turn right into the campground and take the left road, down into the lower section. The parking lot is straight ahead. There is a nice beach and swimming hole a short walk downriver or you can jump straight in on the rocks/grass above a small rapid. Put in is at a bridge near Hwy 3 on Twp Rd 74. From Lundbreck take Highway 3

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west 1.3 km to the intersection at the bottom of the hill. Follow this road north <1km to the old bridge, parking and launch available downstream of the bridge on the either side.

TAKE-OUT

Takeout is at the bridge on Twp Rd 74C. From Lundbreck, take Highway 3 west 1.3km to the intersection at the bottom of the hill. Turn north and follow this road <1km to a bridge, parking available on the either side of the bridge. Do not block gates or driveways.
