MATH:

We will begin Unit 2 which focuses on fact strategies such as combinations of 10, double facts, 10 frames and turn around facts. I really want the students to memorize the combinations of 10 and the doubles facts to 20. These are considered "helper facts" for harder addition problems. Students will have math homework most nights except Fridays. Thank you for helping your child complete the homework each night and returning it to school the next day.

WRITING:

We will be working this month on Opinion writing. The students will state their opinion on a given topic and use a graphic organizer to organize their thoughts on a topic. They will then take that graphic organizer and write a paragraph from it. The students will learn to indent the paragraph using a strategy called "orange square".

READING:

Thank you for having your child read each night for about 20 minutes. Thank you for making reading fun and part of your nightly routine!

The students are enjoying all the books that come with our reading curriculum. Each week the books fit a certain theme. October's themes include: memory stories, an author study on Tomie dePoala, and exploring the natural world of insects!

We also read a big book together! The big books are nonfiction and the students are learning facts about some cool animals!

Phonics:

Your child will learn about words that contain final e and consonant digraphs sh, ch, tch, th, wh, ph, ng, nk. For each lesson, your child will read a story that focuses on the lesson skill.
