He cannot access any data on how much I'm making him from his newsletter since it's directing to some geeky page that looks fancy but don't have any software to track this. (typical designer)

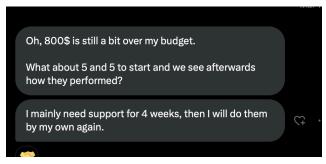

I think that's not a good strategy and that I should do something else. I remember Andrew's lesson where he said to send: Value email \rightarrow Value email \rightarrow soft sell email \rightarrow hard sell email

And even though he is making \$10k/mo he has a headache when I propose extra things for a few hundred bucks like below:



And I still don't think selling on email is the right way for what he is doing. He and I thought about FB ads but he doesn't want me to do them. He said he could do this by himself like he is either arrogant or he didn't think I could deliver results.

I've been stuck for months and I have no idea how I can help him so far.

Every template is different and it's for different needs.

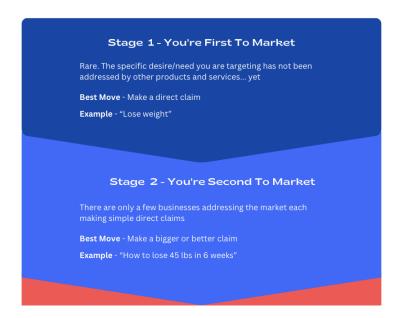
For example course template for those who sell courses.

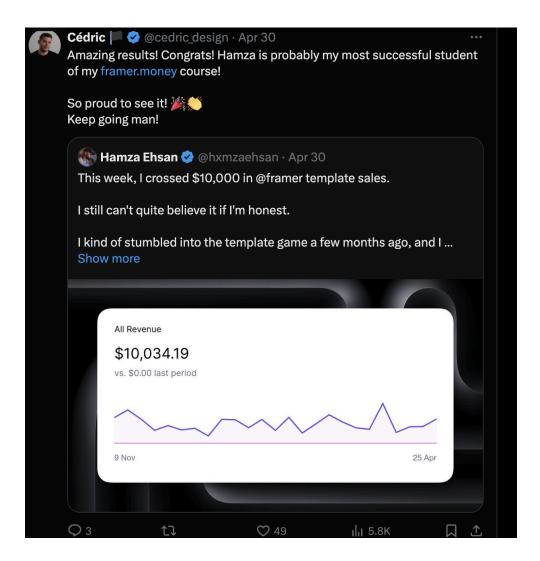

And also, I noticed something weird.

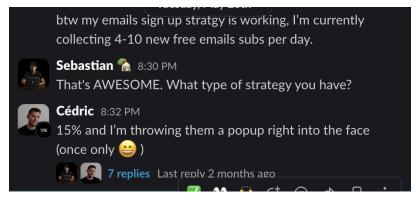

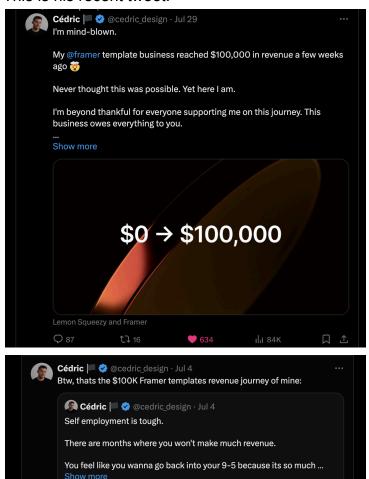

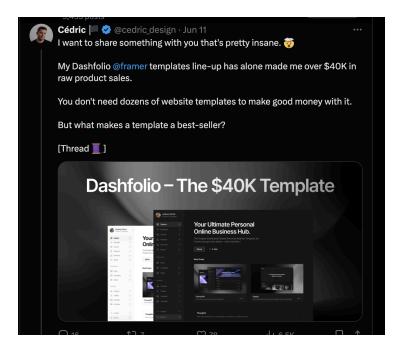
