



2023-2024 Family/Parent Engagement Policy

The faculty, family/parents, staff, and community members of the Del Valle Opportunity Center shall develop and agree upon a written policy for parental involvement during the development and review of the campus improvement plan.

- The Family/Parental Engagement Policy will be posted through Parent Square and accessible on the DVOC website.
- It will be the responsibility of school staff to establish a two-way communication process with parents and families regarding their child(ren's) academic progress. This should include, but not be limited to: parent phone calls, counselor communication regarding earned credits, and scheduled meetings.
- DVOC will make every effort to communicate with family/parents in a language that they understand.
- DVOC will hold an annual Title I meeting for parents and community to discuss the Title I program. Included in the conversation will be information regarding the school's curriculum and types of academic assessments used to measure student progress/proficiency levels that students are expected to meet.
- Monthly meetings will be held the first Thursday of every month at 8:00 AM, 12:00 Noon and 5:30 PM (must provide at least 2 opportunities).
- Parents will be given the opportunity to provide input and make recommendations regarding the Campus Improvement Plan, the Title I program, Family/Parent Compact and the Family/Parent Engagement Policy through the scheduled parent engagement meetings.
- In order to meet the changing needs of our school, the Family/Parent Engagement Policy will be reviewed/updated during the annual Campus Improvement Plan revision process.
