Eligibility

At the time of application the candidate must have:

- ☐ Achieved a minimum GPA of 2.5+ from last semester and in good standing with attendance
- ☐ Attended WHS for one semester immediately prior to applying for office.
- ☐ Submit a completed application by Friday, 4/3/26 4pm.
- ☐ NOTE: Candidates running for office must submit the grade, [attendance and behavior checklist](#) with approval from all teachers and including one of the following approvals: a counselor, teacher, coach or club advisor you have personally worked with as a leader in the past.

Agreements if Elected to Office

- ☐ I agree to fulfill my duties as described in the [ASB Constitution](#).
 - ☐ I agree to promote a positive image at all times to all people both on the WHS campus and in the community. **I agree to be on time and participate in all required ASB events.**
 - ☐ I understand I may be removed from office due to inappropriate behavior, poor attendance (13+ Saturday Schools or more than 15 excused/unexcused absences in a semester) or suspension from school for any discipline reason.
 - ☐ I understand I will be suspended from office if I do not achieve a 2.5 GPA
 - ☐ I understand my duties begin immediately after the election, continue during the summer, and throughout the following school year.
 - ☐ I understand I will have to attend [ALL House of Reps](#) meetings and wear black and gold on Fridays.
 - ☐ I understand this is a year long commitment. I understand that all class officers should enroll in Leadership Class at the beginning of the year and that Junior and Senior Class officers and commissioners **must be enrolled** in the ASB Leadership class 6th Period. For 9th-10th grades: it is an option if it fits in your schedule, but you must attend a monthly Class Officer meeting.
 - ☐ Elected Class Officers automatically serve as [Student Government](#) Commissioners. All other ASB students interested will be placed as a commissioner on one of the six committees during the Summer Institute the week (Flex or after school in May or after graduation June 9th-12th, 2026) by a simple majority vote and with the approval of the Activities Director. The teams are Spirit, Athletic, [Student Government](#), Club and Public Relations and Student Store).
1. Candidates will read and record their speeches on video on April 23rd, which will play on Catz News and Advisory and posted on grade level Google Classrooms and on 5-star for the elections.
 2. In your 1-2 minute speech, please include items such as:
 - a. How have you participated in school events and made our campus better?
 - b. What positive influence will you bring to the school as a Class Officer or ASB Commissioner?
 - c. How will you work with others to create a successful leadership team?
 3. Election results will be announced by Mr. Gregorio the following school day after the election.

Campaigning

1. Campaigning may begin once the student is checked for eligibility.
2. Paper and paints are available in K107– **NO COPIES! Hand painted signs only!**
3. All media must be positive and school appropriate.
4. Posters may be hung on windows with painters tape.
5. All posters must promote positive qualities of the Candidate.
6. Candidates **MUST** respect each other's campaigning in person and online.
7. Candidates may NOT spend more than \$50 on supplies or gifts for the campaign. (ASB may ask for receipts.)
8. All campaign posters must be removed from campus after the election.

Failure to remove any posters after election will be at risk of disqualification
