


When did you join Project Catalyst for the very first time?









Which platform do you use as your primary source of information about Project Catalyst? 856 responses





"Catalyst brings funding options for people that would otherwise sit on their ideas. So I think it helps foster general innovation and not just blockchain related. Even if the vote counting needs to be improved with DIDs to have a more fair system, I want to participate in catalyst more than voting for my own country president (which I feel is useless)"

"Almost everything is on point-the voting interface made easy, proposals sorted and categorized nicely etc"

"It has been best learning experience for me to express, initiate and finish open-source projects"

"Big fan. Will apply for funding for the first time next round."

What community feels needs some more work? 💪 Selected Ouotes:

"On the whole, the catalyst is OK at the moment for where Cardano is, but in future when Cardano scales catalyst will need to potentially handle allocation s in tens of millions per project. Ideascale needs to be easy to use slick and professional."

"I found that I didn't really know where to start and that I was wasting a lot of time trying to find something I was interested in voting for. Like most things, they're needs to be a an engaging story or reason why. I'm not a dev or technical crypto person, but I love the functionality of Ada and is products. Catalyst is lacking in generating the same excitement to users like myself."

"I have a hard enough time on boarding friends/family. Crypto is still pretty nerdy and not super user friendly. Hard to on board avg user and explain wallets/defi and those dumb native tokens."

"Catalyst is a very valuable and awesome project, but it is too complicated for the ordinary ada holder, which results from the nature of the project. We just have to rely on the zealots of the cardano community to oversee the correct direction of the project. Fingers crossed! Cardano is the best!"





"Only english language"

"Not easy to understand/review the different proposals. Ideally should be easier to get a better understanding to vote with a deeper sense of purpose"

"Ideascale is not working in my country well. Processes are always changing and difficult to adapt once you lose connection."

"Most of my friends aren't interested in crypto. If they were I would recommend Bitcoin first. If they were already invested in BTC then I would introduce them to ADA. If they were in ADA, then I would recommend them to look into Project Catalyst. It's a process for most people to reach this point."

"It's massive task read all proposals though app. UX/UI is not good."

"I don't trust the voting system yet."

"As of almost all blockchain alike projects, you need to be an advanced IT user to use projects/apps like this. It is key to connect the average user, so once you tell them about a project like this. It is easy to explain and to use."

"Fragmented and scattered information, takes too long to get informed enough to decide if a deeper dive in is of interest"

"You need to spend a long time to know the players, what they are up to, who is who, the tech. DReps with proper accountability and unbiased thoughts are pretty much needed"

"Need to be ultra geeky to understand something about Catalyst and the vast majority of proposal."

"There are so many proposals that it is difficult to vote, and it is also difficult for an amateur to judge the quality of the proposals."

"I would recommend only because I believe catalyst is an excellent way for the community to secure funding for great ideas and improvements. But it's not a simplistic process yet."

"It's a good way to get funding but the ideascale interface isn't the best"

"Project Catalyst holds the keys to decentralized collaboration and innovation funding, and it is very exciting to be a part of. As it stands, participation still seems restricted to smaller groups of people with skills or an interest in emergent or exponential tech, crypto funds or decentralized governance. This is still currently a niche field of interest."

"I'm new to voting and i'm not sure what the impact of voting will be to Cardano overall"

"I feel that a lot of votes are based on a project you know and like but not based on a fair access to the information of all

Projects. I vote A because I know A. I could have vote B but I don't get info on B easily enough to think about checking B"

"I think the overall vision is really cool, but the UI is not easy enough for people like my parents/friends that aren't already into the space"

"Difficult and time consuming to onboard from scratch (having to explain what it is and its purpose, how to use it, which apps to use, the 500 Ada requirement etc.)."





"There are too many nominations, it is very difficult to read all of them. So we need to qualify and choose a useful idea which brought Cardano to a sustainable and expandable chain before the Catalyst start.Less than 10 nominations."

"I actually would not even know where to point them for how to get involved. It might be worth a few minutes at the beginning of every town hall to briefly cover the roles in catalyst and how anyone gets involved. If this is not clear as I listen to the town halls every few weeks, that seems like a problem. Even though this is repetitive to include in every town hall, I still think it's very important so that it sinks in and everybody knows the main roles and catalyst and how to explore those roles. The beginning resources etc. That shouldn't take more than three to five minutes at the beginning of every call and will be extremely valuable for the life and vitality of the catalyst. Both to welcome new members or random pass or buys and to keep funneling people towards roles that they are interested in"

"Excellent concept and community, but voting process has been an unfair mess since Fund 9"

"The process isn't easy to follow for first time users"

"The reduced input from several OG active friendly voices has left the atmosphere fairly flat in comparison to earlier Funds. Less appealing for newcomers."

"it is a necessary process for cardano, however, both selecting proposals and voting with the app are extremely time-consuming. it's really hard to recommend this burden to others."


"Catalyst is a very promising voting platform to ensure future governance but more Holders need to be aware that votes are happening as they are investing in the ecosystem. Its like with political votes in democracies will spend heavily on marketing yet the only way you can be aware of votes currently is viewing certain wallets or seeing social media posts, access to previous votes would be great to see impact from results and more money marketing cardano would bring more users into the ecosystem"

"Large communities have more chances regardless of the interest of the project."

"Voting is strongly skewed towards large holders"

"Lists are too long. Anyone at the bottom doesn't get looked at"

"More assurance that the proposals are from credible proposers"

"To be able to register all my wallets and have more voting power as a result"

"Project verification and more specific categorization of projects"

"Equal voting no matter how big is your bag"

"I fundamentally disagree with proof of stake based voting unless 'stake' is defined more broadly than just amount of ADA."





"Randomization of order that options are shown"

"Large holders were able to down vote competitors last round, but the abstain option this time should help"

"Larger wallets deserve more voting power but not to dominate the outcome."

"Give more voting power to small accounts"

"Projects at the top of the list have quicker visibility. Also I struggled finding a way to filter on feasibility and impact."

"Better presentation of projects with pictures, videos and visual content, to better compare and understand projects. Otherwise, only projets with the biggest community attract people"

"I voted yes on so many proposals and the app just deleted them all for no reason. I had to revote again and this happened for 3 times"

"Show voters how their voting power and choices relate to category budgets"

"In fund 10 there was a lot of controversy over whales being able to wipe out votes from smaller projects. Not sure whether this is still the case."

"Need better ways to sort and verify projects"

"Seeing scores on the proposal instead of having to click each one."

"More insight into the projects with video content explaining the projects."

"Metrics measuring fairness"

"It is hard to navigate I suggest to be able to upload video on catalyst where they explain their proposal"

"Better understanding. From what I've read online, voting is inspiring skewed towards larger wallets. Hardly democratic."

"My thoughts on this are still developing, but I do believe there is too much power being held by the top 1% of wallets"

"Higher simplicity in navigating through proposal in the sense that the proposals considered more useful for cardano as a whole have higher visibility compared to others. One cannot read through every proposal so what ends up happening is that already affirmed projects get much higher visibility through media while independent projects which may have a big impact are to be scavenged within the huge list of proposal making it difficult for average cardano user to be sure they are voting in the best interests of cardano rather than for the personal objectives of some."

"Follow through to check if the fund are used well. Self voting to getting Fund is not a good practice."

"The community reviews aren't always accurate. It is clear some reviewers don't read the full proposals and their scores can greatly impact a projects perception."

"Application of modern voting concepts such as Quadratic Voting"

"Reduce the pool of proposals actually going to the voting stage, so that people can comfortably read all proposals in each panel and vote for the best. Until then it will continue to be a popularity contest. Remove all 1-3 star proposals"





"Quadratic voting or something similar that enables people with less ada to also have a fair share in decision-making"

"Website that lists all proposals, would allow for better research before voting."

"To many proposals, how should I make a fair choice?"

"The reviewing process needs to improve. Too many good proposals get buried among hundreds of garbage ones."

"A better mix of plutocracy, democracy (when we have Identity) and meritocracy (track record AND better UI/UX that's more informative and allows exploration of topics, favorites even outside the voting app that can link to it for voting; sharing of those favorites, etc)"

"People do not have time to check all proposals, so they will likely gravitate to the first ones near the top of the list and lose patience going down the list. Need a filter to include in order the proposals based on value for the money, or feasibility, etc."

"Implementing a budget cap for each category is essential to be able to determine when a voter should stop voting in a category. Without this, voting power can be diluted or votes cast may not reflect the voter's actual intent if they are aware of when their own votes conflict."

"A short oversight of 1. fund capital available, 2. How much fund available for which category 3. Are the persons/companies checked before submitting their project?checked"

"I'd like to see the outcomes first of having removed downvoting. Too early to say if that had a desirable impact. But that was a big one I was interested to see."

"With hundreds of proposals per category, voters likely get lost into the details of a few proposals that appear at the top of the list. There must be a way to present the proposals so that they have an equal chance of drawing attention from voters."

"Reduce the volume of proposals per funding round, then turn voting power into total castable votes per round so that you can only vote one time per ADA. I also think we should have this be how we select the next round. You have to spend your vote between the active proposals on the table for pass/fail OR vote on eligible proposals to qualify for voting on the next round. Keep the reviewers to make proposals meet min requirements but let the community decide what proposals are available based on a minimum threshold of votes. This will help space out people from spamming each fund with 5 proposals when they have 6 open proposals still under development."

"Better way to categorize proposals. Add an impact statement."

"Since there is no limit to the number of votes, if a voter has a large amount of ADA, the influence will be too large."

"There are many proposals that do not benefit Cardano, and I think it is necessary to narrow down the number of proposals in advance."

"Since it's my first time voting, I wanted to tell you that it seems clunky. Not totally sure how what I voted on will be used or all the proposals to varying degrees."

"You need a factor to reduce the weight of whales and level out the impact of wealth."

"Still undecided about how the Abstain votes work atm. It seems to be a symbolic replacement for the down votes. That said, the system seems to align more closely with legacy voting ballots."





"I like that we are still experimenting with removing the downvote button for example, but I'd still like to see more attempts to make it fair rather than purely controlled by whales. I think having a limit of your total ADA might be worth investigating. Eg. If I have 10,000 ADA I can spend it all to upvote a single project, upvote 5 projects with 2000 etc"

"List how many times a project has already been funded."

"Some reviews like I see still have to have enough minimum character to get requirements. They only type general thing, not focus in detail and give the reason why they think like that. Need more LV2 reviews"

"Maybe some slight tapering of value for whales but acknowledging they could split accounts anyway"

"More clarity and less proposals (they should be pre-sorted somehow and only leave the top 10 choices of any niche)"

"I think the influence of whales is exacerbated by the inability of most people to take time to go through the voting process. I hope we can either increase non-whale participation through something like the vote delegation we'll see with Dreps, or introduce quadratic voting of some sort."

"There should be better overview, a better catalyst website about new projects that need funding. Catalyst App is missing notifications. Almost forgot to vote. And also had several issues past 2 updates and now app says I need to re-register, without any explanation why."

"Would love to get progress updates on the projects that I vote for and require some milestone completion and gate some of the awarded ada. Projects need to deliver"

"I think the process is correct, but it's necessary more diffusion in other languages to reach more people to participate"

"There are too many votes for a single person to give a fair assessment and vote. A simple mechanism like export/import votes could help a lot, making it possible for people who have the time to share their votes with others, this could work as a first version of catalyst drep"

"I'm not sure if the plutocracy method is the most fair."

"Need to find a mechanism that would prevent voting becoming centralized based on ownership"

"Too many teams, some large and popular, offering no value or trying to game catalyst by marketing within the same or different categories"

"I cannot prove it is fair; I just believe it is fair"



"Stop requiring two apps for voting, stop ting some random pin and code to voting. Let people vote with their wallet password."

"I want to find it by keyword or break down the classification by category It's hard to see the last item. It would also be nice to have a full translation for Koreans. It's hard because it's mobile."

"Autovote to select all DFP at once"

"Add a trending feature or a "critics" top choices, exciting new ideas, or dev recommended projects. Idk, something that makes a non technical person feel like they can contribute but doesn't have to read every proposal. Or if there are two similar proposals, at the bottom of the proposal offer the recommendation to check out the similar proposal."

"More flow into the voting selection, once you select yes no vote, to jump into the next one to vote"

"Its difficult to find proposals I read on X in the proposal list"





"When I tap the heart icon, they are not accessible for later review."

"Alow users to prepare votes before the voting starts so they don't have to go through them all again"

"See a random order of reviews in each proposal"

"I can't read all the proposals. I'd like to be able to share my favorite list and similarly be able to import the favorites of others that I trust."

"Using a person like myself, who is new to this process, but very accustomed to webpage use is critical to make the pages, more user-friendly and easy to understand"

"Shorten dramatically the number of votes and sections. Make sure the app is stable build."

"Option to select and vote all proposals with impact > x"

"This PIN always makes me trouble."

"Seems to be getting easier over time, but still a lot of scrolling and searching. Not sure how to improve though"

"Really appreciate not having to scroll back to your current location while navigating the proposals, big help!"

"Maybe seeing exactly how much voting power is allocated."

"It requires a lot of reading and knowledge to be able to make an informed decision. Having some option that simplifies the idea and impact in a way more people could understand would lead to better, more informed decisions"

"More languages should be supported for people who don't speak English"

"Would like to have a search tool to that browse through all proposals by Idea nbr"

"My last complaint regarding displaying an alert if you're eligible to receive voting rewards was added. This was my number one complaint and happy it was added.

"Is there a browsert voting app? Mobile was hard to view"

"desktop version"

"Make it easy to swipe between proposals when voting, rather than tapping little arrows. I also feel like the dialog box that pops up after voting is unnecessary and I usually just immediately tap out of it so I can continue voting."

"A rating or filter to identify mature, legitimate project teams would be helpful."

"Check marks that all multiple selections of approve or abstain"

"Search is off even if using exact keywords."

"My selected votes did not save. Whenever I closed the app, my selected votes were lost. This made it so I had to review and cast votes all at one time. Very tedious."

"Have the possibility to preserve my votings before casting. Currently when you close the app all voted are lost"





"Pending votes should be saved. I vote during multiple days and only at the end of the voting period I submit my votes. In Fund 11 I had to start from the beginning 3 times because my pending votes were gone the next day. Really crappy experience"

"I've spent a whole day reading proposal and selecting which ones to vote yes on and which ones to abstain without singing to wake up the next morning and find out that all my selection are gone, having to redo it a gain was horrible"

"I don't know if I'm diluting one vote by voting for to many proposals in the same category"

"Im new to voting but perhaps ability to choose multiple filters at once e.g price + impact"

"When I closed my app for a day it lost all the votes that were pending."

"Always make sure that there is a 'return to voting' option when navigating. It should always take you back to the proposal list you were parsing, included filtered or organized lists."

"I think there should be a way to filter the proposals by categories. I know there's 5 sections but it would be great to have filters like NFTs, gaming, infrastructure, security,...."

"Can we put the review score in the front proposal's page? So we can screen the proposal first, before opening the reviews in each categories."

"A survey of my interests or knowledge to pre-sort the proposals would be nice."

"Currently need to switch between systems to get all the information required to make a decision. It's time consuming and not practical at all."

"I spent hours voting but not submitting. Later upon returning my pending votes all disappeared and I had to start over."

"The application is easy to use but the difficult thing is to go and check all the proposals, which by seeing the quantity, it is difficult. I believe that by better categorising them it would be easier to assess and find the ones that I am interested in."

"I'm still not 100% sure how the voting mechanism works. I can vote for several different projects I like. But not sure how many votes go to each project. Whether I should vote for my Number 1 preference or do all projects voted for get equal votes?"

"Better categorization of topics and proposals"

"The votes were gone. Had to try to vote 3 times"

"Give filters for each category to select proposals by score in impact, feas, audit"

"The app is slightly convoluted to dig through and find the best things to vote for. Too many clicks to get to information."

"I find it a bit challenging to navigate on mobile, but that's mostly due to the plethora of proposals. It's a bit of an exhausting endeavor."

"Filters needs to stick when you navigate to and from proposals as you review for voting."

"Remember pending votes between app restarts"





"I voted on several things but they all got deleted before i submitted them. Just submit the votes before ending and starting another session."

"can we add a filter on | selection!"

"An easier way to see your hearted proposals and the ability to "vote yes to all hearted proposals" instead of having to go into each one"

"I'd love to just be able to vote on one item and then automatically be directed to the next proposal in my queue."

"Voting directly from project catalyst or easy user experience between voting app and porject Catalyst"

"Cache vote progress. I had to re-select proposals 3 times because I closed the app before the final submission of the votes"

"I think having an easier way to back up your voting pin would be useful. Perhaps to have it saved somewhere on the wallet? Almost forgot mine!"

"More consistent UI (open source logo missing from search results); easier to make/change selection, particularly in bulk; better search input (e.g. 1-click clear)"

"When select your vote for a project, go directly to the next one, instead of to displaying the list."

"There are many proposal so temporary "basket" the preferred one to "my selection" would make sense. The favorite is a layer 1 filter, then adding to basket gives a second round of consideration."

"Doing the voting on a phone is not very effective, should be possible to do this on a computer"

"A way to show how much of the categories funds I have voted for"

"I first set my goal to look into those with 4/5 aggregate and above for each of the sections. Then if indeed 4/5 and above, I read the problem statement and the solution statement. Then read the negative comments with 1/5 and 2/5 in the impact section. Thereafter I assess and decide to vote yes or not. Therefore, I think it would help to find all the ratings in one glance on the list of the proposals and there is a feature that allows me to search for the two negative ratings on each of the section. Presently I have to click on each section sequentially and determine the 4's of 5 and painfully scroll up and down to find the 1 or 2 of 5 ratings."

"Need the app to save when I select to list proposals in a manner other than the default of random. Don't like losing my place due to a misclick and needing to start from the top."

"Either possibility to connect wallets or a solution to export and import votes. Also a desktop browser application to vote would be nice."

"Saving concept votes! Best approach is to take several days to read and judge the proposals, but unfortunately all my.work from day 1 was not saved... that was frustrating."

"Looking forward to the implementation of the voting function from a web browser."

"I made selections in the app, closed it a while later by accident and when I came back all my selections were gone. That cost me a bit of time."

"better filter mechanism on project data and the ability for the app to memorize the votes over many days before sending your selection, also a live dashboard with vote results should be possible in the future, but great to see all new features from fund 10 onward like the stop on down voting..."





"I marked selections, but didn't have time to finish. When I came back, the selections were gone. Almost gave up trying again."

"Web version. Hard to review details on phone"

"Budget cap, allow for custom tags to be added to projects by proposers so that projects can be found by a tag and not just by proposer name or proposal title. Expand arrow for proposal ratings should be closer to left side directly under proposal title & details. It was hard to find these expand arrows from a UX perspective. Visible star rating or 5/5 style rating without expanding would be helpful and save time with voting. When searching proposals by name or proposer, the category of the proposal is also not currently visible, making it very difficult to manually calculate a budget cap for each category."

"Fix the app so votes you've selected before voting aren't removed. If the phone is turned off info is gone!"

"The app is way better than before but still need an advanced filtering system based on proposals tags (finance, gaming, dev, real world applications, music,..)"

"I'm thinking when AI gets a bit better, maybe some quick summaries of each proposal?"

"Perhaps a little more about the project in the summary."

"Switch more easily between impact, feasibility, and value reviews; going back is tedious and loses place."

"A more simple way to see proposals categorized"

"Make it easier to view the overall review scores without having to read every one individually. To really take time to learn about a proposal takes in my opinion an unwarranted amount of time. I would imagine it also leads to rushed decisions."

"The app did not save my bookmarked proposals across a hard refresh. Requiring me to spend the time to manually search and input the formation at least twice to vote once. Additionally, I needed to vote with multiple wallets, and had to repeat the process of manually searching and bookmarking proposals. Additionally the latency of screens on the app is very long. So repeating the process at least four times is more time than it's worth. The app needs to be snappy and seamless to incentivize voting."

"This was my first time voting, My IPhone wasn't new enough to be able to vote. I write this from my IPad instead. And this question can be understood in two ways: A "technical" and a "systemic". In both casas my answer is "2""

"Its hard to tell if you voted for everything. When you vote, you don't know when/if you can come back"

"Improvement of registration process in the voting process. Can't voting and registration be made possible in one process?"



"How is impact of financing measured? Who keeps track of results?"

"I honestly feel like good proposals are starting to be come scarce. To much emphasis on "research" or "club" proposals and less on actual useful products."

"We will not know the outcome until an impact is made or not."

"It would be interesting to have, within the app, the progress that voted proposals are doing after that they received findings."





"It seems much better than early rounds, but largely seems to reward the same players repeatedly. It stifles those trying to innovate and bootstrap, which is why the find exists."

"Need more explanations of what the money will be used for, an audi and follow up later"

"How can it be verified that projects will deliver?"

"Its not clear what will be funded yet, so it seems a bit early for this question."

"Testimonials from selected projects in previous funds"

"Publishing and then having a recorded community discussion on the outcomes."

"Maybe a newsletter telling is what the results were and the impact of said votes."

"I need more proof as to how the resources will be used"

"Difficult to follow up.all the proposals so sometimes missing details"

"Winning projects generate and share KPIS information and how they are generating an impact."

"I never read any follow up about the outcomes of a catalyst funding, so I can't say"

"There are too many proposals that are not focused on the ecosystem in my opinion. There are too many games and nft focused proposals which overload the visibility of the advancements that would better help cardano ecosystem."

"Future information about payouts because of reached milestones"

"Follow up to see if the projects are finished (on time) is essential and project that can be easily proved as "done" should not be able to ask more Funds larger then their impact."

"Perhaps a rating system of past funding rounds might prove insightful, which rounds produced the best outcomes and a synopsis of what type of projects in each category."

"Conflict of interest should be avoided in some way"

"A lot of audits and continuations of existing projects, Or translation services. Very few new ideas and new projects"

"Develop a format for reporting detailed project results."

"A public showcase of how voted proposals made a change."

"It will likely fund big players. I wish in the future small projects could get funded more, though catalyst enabling more networking and exploration."

"Most proposals seem too amateurish to generate impactful outcome. We should aim for fewer, but much larger projects done by professionals, not hobbyists and amateurs interested in earning a lot of funding."

"Making proposers include a list of milestones / timeline whether the project is open source or not. I noticed community advisors calling out a lack of clear roadmaps on certain proposals. There is a lot of ada on the line, and the difference between a project worth of support vs a potential sketchy project is transparency. They don't have to give us the entire recipe of "KFC's 11 herbs and spices", but it should be enough that people don't think that the proposer will feed us bs, and pocket some free ADA."

"Perhaps Catalyst can highlight and promote impactful projects on social media"

"The current voting weight favor large existing project that have means of influence. This is different than the initial vision which envisioned Catalyst as a seed fund for risky/small new ideas. Impact will be strong, but not diversified."

"Many proposals seem to surf on the AI buzzwords and make little to no sense technically. I think this reflect the poor quality of early screening process."

"Every proposer must be held accountable for milestones/deliverables. Most of proposals on Ecosystem bucket are likely to provide low or even no value"

"There isn't much public follow up. I also think users that bailed on funded proposals should be ineligible from asking for future ones"

"Risk score for teams and rating score for previously applied funding and what was delivered."

"Impact statement with verifiable metrics"

"I hope they will, but I've seen so many not be followed up on"

"The new parameters are likely over-favoring smaller teams less likely to deliver quality."

"The people that proposing need to change why they are doing what they are doing. A lot of proposals are just there for money and they don't actually believe in themselves. You can see that through the way they are explaining their proposals."

"Progress should be tracked (milestones), if successfully implemented all the funds should be paid out"

"It's hard to keep track of the proposals you voted for development. Maybe if the proposal had to put forward a link to the various methods of communication which updated the voter to the progress."

"Keep track of funded proposals and if they underdeliver or disappear ask for the money back."

"Show proof of delivery of every project who have been founded in the previous catalyst rounds"



Please don't take this too critically it's just for trying to help."

"Not informed about it. Reading many proposals and building my own opinion."

"Now that reviews cannot be challenged by proposers themselves, there appears to be some low quality reviews slipping through the cracks this Fund. Only so much auditing can be done by LV2 moderators (who may be covering up to 300 proposals). However, the details of each proposal are better known by the proposers themselves, who have invested time and effort into writing them. This provides opportunity for some bad actors or low quality reviews to appear valid, even though they may be making clearly false or speculative statements about a proposal, or wildly divergent scoring. Allowing proposers to defend their work in such an instance would add another layer of auditability, and enhance trust in the ranking system."

"More reviewers"

"Make it easy for voters to navigate the ranking system"

"I'm not sure again. It seems like most proposals ranged somewhere between 3-5 in score because it seems reviewers are still hesitant to give low scores. Or maybe it's just easier to score something higher rather than be critical of it."

Of course we manually check and make our own judgments, but for projects I can't fully judge well, sometimes the reviews don't help enough."

"i think it was fair based on reviews that were done to my proposal, but of course there is quite a huge cap between quality of feedback. Some don't seem to read proposal"





category depending on their work in the community to be the ones who review each one to show the compromise they have with cardano"

"Many steps to register. Should really be simpler than this to adopt normal users."

"Less steps to unboard, maybe through DID"

"The app's UI needs to be localized in each language from proposal to voting."

"More step by step guides, videos, & tutorials on the Catalyst / ideascale website"
