Submission Guidelines

- Most of our webinars have a running time of 60 minutes, around 50 minutes with the remaining time spent on Q&A. Please submit a proposal for a topic you can adequately cover in this amount of time.
- You must submit your proposal at least three weeks prior to the proposed webinar time to allow for sufficient promotion, if accepted.
- You will receive a notification as to whether your webinar has been accepted within a week of submission to NYS TESOL.

Evaluation Process

Proposal applications that are incomplete will not be considered for review. Submissions will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Timeliness and relevance of subject matter and alignment with the above theme
- Innovation, creativity and originality of topic
- Clarity, depth and specificity of proposal
- Expertise and experience level of presenter(s)

What would happen once your webinar is scheduled
