Policy Statement:

CQEL is committed to the health and safety of all conference participants. We recognize and respect individual choices regarding masks and encourage adherence to the policies outlined in this document for everyone's well-being.

Health Self-assessment:

All attendees are required to conduct a health self-assessment before entering the venue. Anyone experiencing symptoms related to contagious illnesses should refrain from attending.

Sanitation and Hygiene:

Bathrooms with sinks for handwashing will be available throughout the venue.

Digital Materials:

Where possible, conference materials will be provided digitally to minimize physical contact.

Masking:

While mask-wearing is optional, it is encouraged, especially if you are immunocompromised or work with immunocompromised children or staff.

An immediate response protocol will be enacted if an attendee shows signs of illness during the conference. This includes designated isolation areas and clear guidelines for seeking local medical care.
