

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PRESENTATION OF SCIENTIFIC MANUSCRIPTS FOR SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATIONS:

- Journal "Studies of Wildlife of Kyrgyzstan" (SWK)
- Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences of the Kyrgyz Republic

Publication ethics and rules of scientific publication

The article must be an original unpublished work written in English. It should not have been published previously or be considered for publication in other conference proceedings or journal. The authors whose names appear on the paper have contributed sufficiently to the scientific work and therefore share collective responsibility for the results.

All papers undergo a double-blind, peer review process. First, each presentation is reviewed by the conference editors, who may reject it if it does not relate to the conference theme and does not meet the conference requirements or if it is of poor quality. In the second step of the review process, the paper is sent to an independent reviewer. The reviewers are asked to evaluate the article and may recommend to:

- 1) accept the article in its current form,
- 2) accept the article with minor corrections,
- 3) accept the article with major corrections,
- 4) accept the article only after corrections and reconsideration.
- 5) reject the article.

Reviews include recommendations and comments, which are then sent to the author(s). Editors should not overturn publication decisions unless serious problems are identified.

Editors and reviewers should evaluate manuscripts for intellectual content regardless of the race, gender, sexual orientation, religious beliefs, ethnicity, nationality, or political beliefs of the authors. The editors' decision to accept or reject an article for publication should be based only on the importance, originality, and clarity of the article and the relevance of the research to the purpose of the conference.

An article is successfully presented if the author receives a confirmation email.

Requirements for the preparation of scientific manuscripts

1. The maximum number of authors of one article is not more than five.
2. Each participant can submit not more than two articles.
3. Full length of the article: 12,000 to 30,000 characters (including the list of references).
4. Manuscripts of scientific articles written both in English and Russian are accepted.
5. Format of the article: exclusively doc or docx.
6. The submitted manuscript should strictly correspond to the problems of the Conference and reflect the results of theoretical and experimental research. We accept only original manuscripts of scientific articles.
7. Graphics should be translated into English (if the manuscript is submitted in English) or presented in an editable format (if the manuscript is submitted in Russian).
8. The article must necessarily have the following sections: "Introduction", "Methodology", "Results", "Discussion", "Conclusion", "List of References". Information about financial support is indicated in the "Acknowledgements" section after the "Conclusion".
9. If original statistical data were used in the study, the authors should provide replication data (questionnaires, research protocols, collected and raw statistical data in any form), which will be

published together with the article. This step is an important element in preventing data falsification and provides an additional opportunity to verify the analysis made by the authors.

10. In-text references to the literature and the reference list itself should be organized exclusively according to the APA standard. We strongly recommend that authors use high-quality foreign scientific literature published in reliable scientific journals (indexed in Scopus and Web of Science databases). We strongly ask to minimize the use of “non-representative” sources - Internet resources that do not contain scientific information, textbooks or manuals. The list of sources should include no more than 10% of sources authored/co-authored by the author of the submitted article.

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Authors must ensure that they have written completely original work and if authors have used the work and/or words of others, this has been appropriately cited or quoted. All received manuscripts are checked for textual borrowings using the Anti-Plagiarism program (full check). The originality of the text should be **at least 80%**. It is not allowed to send for consideration already published articles or those articles that have been sent for publication in other editions and are under consideration. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse to publish a manuscript at any stage, if the fact of plagiarism or re-publication of already accepted manuscript text of a scientific article in other scientific editions is found. In this case, the paid organizational fee is not refunded.
