BEAVER BUGGY RULES

Rules and Regulations — Beaver Buggy

BUGGY BUILD

- 1. Weight Limit 300g
- 2. Beaver Buggy must fit the following dimensions:
 - a. Width: must not exceed 70.0 mm
 - b. Length: must not exceed 180.0 mm
 - c. Height: must not exceed 110.0 mm
 - d. Track Clearance: no less than 9.0 mm (3 ½ inches)
 - e. Inside edges of left and right wheels shall be no less than 45 mm (1 ¾ inches) apart
- 3. No loose material of any kind is permitted in or on the Beaver Buggy.
- 4. ***Beaver Buggy bottoms are to remain paint free***

Bottoms should have the youth's name, group name and the year on it.

5. All 4 wheels must be installed.

RACE DAY

- 1. Each Beaver Buggy must pass inspection by the Inspection Committee. Inspection Committee is only looking for issues that may damage the track.
- 2. Only silicone type lubricants can be used.

*** Graphite or oils are not permitted***

- 3. If a Beaver Buggy leaves the track or has parts that have fallen off of the car, repairs will be made and the race will be re-run.
- 4. Any Buggy lights must be off during races
- 5. Prior to races starting, style of tournament will be decided and announced by officials
- 6. First names and Last initial of youth will be made public. If this is an issue let the race team know prior to race day. Pseudonyms will be used.
- 7. Officials are human to, respect is to be paid by all parties to all parties.

Build

- 1. A Buggy must fit the following dimensions:
 - a. Width: must not exceed 70.0 mm
 - b. Length: must not exceed 180.0 mm
 - c. Height: must not exceed 110.0 mm
 - d. Track Clearance: no less than 9.0 mm (3 ½ inches)
 - e. Inside edges of left and right wheels shall be no less than 45 mm (1 ¾ inches) apart
- 2. Weight limit of 500g

RACE RULES - SCOUTERS/PARENTS

- 1. Each Beaver Buggy must pass inspection by the Inspection Committee. Inspection Committee is only looking for issues that may damage the track.
- 2. Only silicone type lubricants can be used.

*** Graphite or oils are not permitted***

- 3. If a Beaver Buggy leaves the track or has parts that have fallen off of the car, repairs will be made and the race will be re-run.
- 4. Any Buggy lights must be off during races
- 5. Prior to races starting style of tournament will be decided and announced by officials
- 6. First names and Last initial of youth will be made public. If this is an issue let the race team know prior to race day. Pseudonyms will be used.
- 7. Officials are human to, respect is to be paid by all parties to all parties.
