 - a. Summer Projects in progress - Roofs are being replaced, the parking lot repairs are done, the elementary gym expansion project has started, Ryan Curtis is working on replacing siding on the teacherages, and we have replaced the countertops in Mr. Driskell's classroom.
 - b. Athletic Camps -
 - i. Football camp in Dufur was last week, we had 18 student athletes attend. It was a great time for bonding and for the upperclassmen to take leadership roles.
 - ii. The volleyball team just got back from Arizona - they had a week long camp/tournament in Phoenix. This was a great opportunity to play against teams from all over the country.
 - c. Medquest Camp - This camp will be held July 7th - July 10th. Thirty two kids are signed up this year, they will come stay in our dorms and we will bus them back and forth to their various engagements. They meet with health professionals

around the county and will have the opportunity to use our Paxton Patterson Health modules.
