The general rule about double and triple completion is that courses cannot repeat. For example, Medical Terminology cannot be used for completion in both Health Science and Sports Medicine. It can only count for 1 of the programs. See examples below:

CATE completion occurs when students complete the coursework for any (3 or 4 course) program <u>and</u> the required industry certification.	Double CATE completion occurs when students complete the course work for any <u>2</u> programs and at least 1 industry certification. Once a course is used to complete one program, it <u>cannot</u> be used to complete another program. An example of double completion in Sports Medicine and Health Science: • Health Science 1, 2, Medical Terminology + BLS certification • Sports Medicine 1, 2, 3 OR completion in Accounting and IT: • Accounting 1, 2, Entrepreneurship • Health Science 1, 2, Medical Terminology + BLS certification	Triple CATE completion occurs when students complete the course work for any <u>3</u> programs and at least 1 industry certification. Again, once a course is used to complete one program, it <u>cannot</u> be used to complete another program. An example of triple completion in Culinary Arts, General Management and CORE Engineering • Culinary Arts 1, 2, and Introduction to Culinary Arts + ServSafe • Accounting 1, Entrepreneurship, Social Media & Business • CORE Engineering 1, 2, 3, 4
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
