

TEEBOARD BETA PATCH NOTES:

v0.0.2 beta 2014-03-14

- Removed the "Stats" toggle switch (bottom left). May or may not add it back later, not decided yet.
- Added Donation Tracker view. **Not functional yet.**
(there's already some code running in the background but still have to work out how to turn it into a viewable experience.
- Added Donations toggle switch (bottom left). **Not functional yet.**
- Followers widget is now fully implemented. **100% functional.**
Check the "help" video via the system tray icon for more info (25:15 is where the widget info starts).

- The list of latest followers (Followers widget view) now also displays the date next to their name.
- You can now remove a user from the Users Window (icon on the top left). The currently active user can not be removed, which also means that if only one user is present (authorized), it can not be removed. This may change, but not decided yet.
- Fixed a bug with the Clock widget's background transparency.
- Added a drop shadow option to the Clock widget.

You will have to manually copy the clock widget from the application install directory to the user documents directory.

The default install location is: C:\Program Files (x86)\Air\Gip\TeeBoard\widgets\clock\

Copy (and overwrite) the "clock" folder to: C:\Users\[USERNAME]\Documents\TeeBoard\widgets\

- Added the "Bitrate Calculator" under "Misc. Tools". **100% functional.**
- All widgets now have a "preview" button that will open the widget in a pop out window for testing so you can now make changes and preview them immediately, without having to run the widget in OBS or XSplit.

Note however that you can only have one instance of each widget active, meaning that if the widget is running in OBS or XSplit, you should not open the widget preview in TeeBoard and vice versa.

- Added a "help" option to the right click menu in the system tray.
Selecting "help" will open a new window displaying a YouTube playlist (more videos will be added later).
- Added a "patch notes" option to the right click menu in the system tray.
Selecting "patch notes" will open a new window displaying the latest patch notes from google docs (yes, this document).
- Added "Channel Panels" under "Misc. Tools". **Work in progress.**
The idea is for a user to be able to generate images (panels) for their channel.
