Girls LAX (Jenna Dellano)- No email update

Football (Melissa Dewey, Tony Genao, Brandon Smith)-

- Registration is complete
- No current coaching needs
- A grant has been submitted for money towards new pads/pants
- Looking for parents to maintain Bushkill Field lines
- Snack stand made over \$3000 this weekend
- Fundraising- Fall mums/candles will go out this week
- No off season training
- \$675 to Lower Nazareth for Snack Stand countertops

Field Hockey (Melissa Choe)-

- Registration closed
- All Head Coaches needed to pass 4 module tests. All information was emailed to the Head Coaches
- Uniforms for players and coaches' shirts were handed out on August 16th
- Tuskes Fields (lower and middle fields) being used for practice and games
- Parents will need to line the field hockey fields only once to receive their work bond check back. There is a sign up genius to sign up for field lining

Cheer (Alisha Bailey, Kristen McGaughran)-

- Coaching is sufficient and without issue at all levels
- All clearances are up to date
- Waiting on a Varsity fill order for larger sizes for uniforms. The fill order for Flag uniforms has been received. All uniforms have been handed out
- Went with a less expensive bow option this year because of the new style that is current. Quality isn't as good so they've been replaced as needed. This is still a more cost efficient option
- Practices at Rocket Elite have been confirmed for Mondays, Wednesdays, and the Fridays/Saturday (November 1st) before each competition
- Practices have been confirmed at Shafer LGI Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays
- Sign up genius for parent volunteering is out and team moms have been chosen
- Working with football to supply food for the snack stand for home games
- Fundraising- Bingo is next week (September 13th). Competition fundraiser is due this week. The apparel stand will be combined with football and run like the snack stand
- There has been some negative feedback on the quality of Bishop photos. I did advise Linda at Bishop. We've used Bishop for a long time and this has been the second year of complaints. The future commissioners and board may want to discuss other option for the future.

Softball-no email update

- Board met after commissioners resigned. After careful consideration, it was determined that the softball program does not have enough resources and is no longer feasible. We will be consolidating with NASBA

Boys LAX (Mike Koch)-

- Fall Skills and Drills will have 30 players participating
- We will sponsor a box lacrosse team in the 5-6 division
- Spring registration will open in December
- A list of coaches will be sent for approval later this fall
- All equipment was returned or rented for the summer
- This year we played at Silvercrest and the NAMS turf field when available. Our intention for the 2026 season will be to do the same
- Fall skill sessions will be held at Silvercrest September and October
- Box Season at the St. Luke's Sports Center in Whitehall
- Fundraising-Sales for our annual cakes, pies, and candles fundraiser yielded \$1300 and our apparel sale was \$500. Roughly \$300 was raised from picture sales. Fundraising for 2026 will be similar
