This consists of the approach; focus and locus of research/population and sample; data collection techniques and analysis techniques. (Arial font -12- normal).

Results And Discussion [Arial font - 14 –bold- normal]

1. Results

This section describes the results of the study that may be equipped with tables, figures (graphs), and/or diagrams. Results should be clear and concise. The results should summarize (scientific) findings rather than provide data in detail. The Arabic transliteration using the international standard IJMES Transliteration Chart (Arial font -12- normal).

How to Write Figures and Tables?

Figures

Figure should be in grayscale, and if it made in color, it should be readable when it later printed in grayscale. Caption should be numbered in single spaced. A caption should comprise a brief title (not on the figure itself) and a description of the illustration. Keep text in the illustrations themselves to a minimum but explain all symbols and abbreviations used. The lettering on the artwork should be clearly readable and in a proportional measure. Figures should have a brief description in the main body of text.

For lay outing purpose, please provide the additional respective high-resolution figure ($\geq 300\text{dpi}$) separately in .tif/.jpg/.jpeg within a particular folder apart from the manuscript. Moreover, kindly avoid mentioning position of figure/table e.g., “figure below” or “table as follow” because the position will be rearranged in lay outing process. DO NOT put boxes around your figures to enclose them.

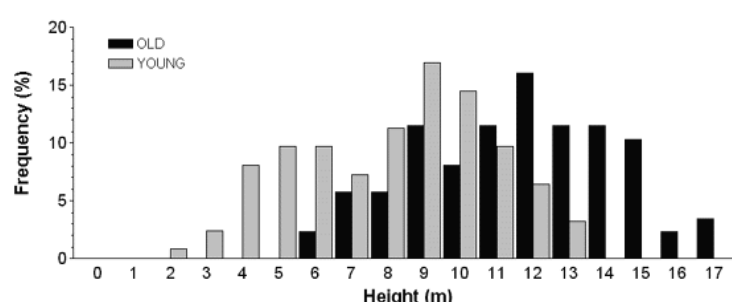


Figure 1. Sample

Tables

Number tables consecutively in accordance with their appearance in the text. Place footnotes to tables below the table body and indicate them with superscript lowercase letters. Avoid vertical rules. Be sparing in the use of tables and ensure that the data presented in tables do not duplicate results described elsewhere in the article

2. Discussion

This section discusses the results of the finding, analysis and elaborate with other researches. The discussion should explore the significance of the results of the work, not repeat them. It contains specific or unique findings from the results of the study. Any possible follow-up activities may also be addressed in this section. The Arabic transliteration using the international standard IJMES Transliteration Chart. [Arial font – 12 –normal].

Conclusions [Arial font - 14 –bold- normal]

The conclusion contains the answer of the research problem and it is written in a description paragraph (not numbering).

Recommendation and implication contain limitations that need to be followed up in future research agenda. [Arial font – 12 –normal].

References [Arial font - 14 –bold- normal]

References consist of at least 20 references include 80% reputable scientific journals published at least the last 10 years. Authors should ensure that every reference in the text appears in the list of references and vice versa. Scriptwriting and citation referred to in this paper are required using application of reference manager in **Mendeley or Zotero**. References are written in APA format 6th Edition.
