Personal Journey & Calling Six years ago I walked on to OSU campus. I had no idea what I would go through in those next four years of college. I didn't know the struggles I would face in my spiritual faith being away from home, nor the paths and choices I would make in the coming years that would lead me away from Christ. Six years ago, a college ministry invited me into their community and walked alongside me as I struggled in college with social pressures, personal choices, and my identity. And because of this ministry I was brought back to Christ in college, built up and encouraged in the Bible, and equipped to pursue and lead other college students and build them up as disciples for Christ. This year God called me back to the role of evangelizing and building disciples of Christ at OSU through Campus Ambassadors!

The Need

OSU has just over 30,000 students on campus. This year alone, there were 7,146 new incoming freshmen, which is the largest incoming class in OSU history. College is the time in which students leave their homes and established communities and enter an environment where their identity is placed primarily in the pressures of academics and social groups. Today's world has made the topic of identity subjective and fluid, which creates instability. Last year statistics found...

- 77% of college students experienced moderate to serious psychological stress
- 35% were diagnosed with anxiety
- 27% struggled with depression

These issues can manifest in different ways such as drinking, drugs, or even dropping out of college. It is apparent they need truth, and my desire is to reach students with the Gospel, which will give them a life where their identity is in Christ!

The Opportunity I am excited to be joining staff with Campus Ambassadors, where I will use my degree in Psychology and what I am learning in my master's in Christian Leadership studies to influence the next generation of leaders. I am also looking forward to seeing how God will use the many years of experience He's given me in walking students through the discipleship process, and I would like to invite you to join me in this transformational work.
