
LEFT SIDE -- "THE STUDENT SIDE"

The left side of the page demonstrates your understanding of the information from the right side of the notebook. The left side incorporates and reflects how you learn S.S. as well as what you learn in S.S.

THE KEYS TO A FABULOUS LEFT SIDE

- Title, Date, Page Number
- Every left page gets used.
- Always use MULTIPLE COLORS... They help the brain learn and organize information. Highlight key terms, definitions, or illustrate with color.
- Write neatly and clearly.
- Homework problems are usually on this side.
- If no assignments are specifically mentioned for the left page, it becomes a YOUR CHOICE assignment. Choose a CLOCK QUESTION below and do the activity for the page. Label which CLOCK QUESTION you are using. You should not use the same one over and over. Show variety!
