

MCHS Required Paperwork for Coaching Staff

All coaches (paid or volunteer) are required to complete annual paperwork and training. Mt. Carmel uses a website called Home Campus to keep track of all coach and athlete paperwork. This list is to help you understand the specifics of what's required and keep track.

PUSD uses a different website, <u>JPA Learning</u>, for state mandated training which apply to all school staff. CIF also has a <u>page on their website</u> for information about some of these coaching requirements.

Home Campus: Coaches

Use the <u>Home Campus</u> Coach Login page to create a free account, electronically sign paperwork, and upload certificates.

Health related certificates (except CPR) are offered free through NFHS Learn. If you think you may have completed these certificates within the last 2 years, you can look it up without logging in.

Required pap	erwork fo	r ALL c	coaches:
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□ CIFSDS Code of Ethics – signed annually
□ PUSD Coaching In-service Acknowledgement – signed annually, you should receive a PowerPoint/PDF via email and/or during coach meeting
□ CPR/AED/First Aid for children and adults – valid for 2 years, must include a hands-on skills portion and must be done through either Save-A-Life Educators, American Red Cross, or American Heart Association
□ Concussion & Head Injury Education – valid for 2 years
□ Heat Illness Prevention Training – valid for 2 years
□ Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) Awareness Training – valid for 2 years
□ Fundamentals of Coaching Education – never expires

Required for Cheer and Dance Coaches only:

☐ Cheer and Dance Spirit Safety Course – never expires

Required for Water Sports only beginning 2020-21 school year:

□ <u>Lifeguard Certification</u> – valid for 2 years and must be completed through American Red Cross. This may also be used as your CPR/AED/First Aid certification. PUSD has trainings a couple of times throughout the year. Ask AD for dates and times.
