- Board of Education Report Mrs. Katie Timmers:
  - Last Wednesday, entire BOE and most of Admin gathered for retreat and covered:
    - OH School Board Association liaison talked about best practices
    - Communication Update: BOE members will not respond directly to comments on social media, Katie Cho (District Comms Director) will respond
      - All BOE members live streamed and recording is available next day
      - Finance update

#### **Treasurer's Report**:

- Fall Festival Sept 21st
  - Great pre-sale on wristbands
  - Sponsorships and Vendors are going well
    - Currently, we anticipate breaking even
    - Vendor Pricing from 2021 is the same, we did NOT raise prices
      - Modified it a bit to make sure it is accessible to all in our community
    - Building out volunteer and sponsor database
- Mums Sale

- 140 currently sold, estimated profit of \$1100
- School Supplies Fundraiser
  - 380 schools supplies for K-6 students, special thank you to Katie and Janelle for coordinating this fundraiser
- Hot Lunch
  - Denay asked about hot lunch pricing and why it went up
    - We did a comprehensive analysis and compared to the prices charged.
    - Last year's treasurer (Adrienne) did a great job breaking down costs.
    - We had over \$9k in PayPal fees last year and there is a fee every time someone orders, which needs to be accounted for.
    - We were not accounting for utensils, etc. and other material expenses (hot lunch software), which also need to be accounted for
  - First Food Truck Wednesday:
    - Truck paid us \$75 to be there, it is easy requires minimal/no lift from us.
    - Next Wednesday Smashdog
    - Wednesday 9/25 Toledo Chuck Wagon
  - o Julie Hot Lunch Co-Chair Elementary School
    - Added bottled water to the menu this year, have added a \$200 profit this month alone, added recycling to the lunch periods

#### **Vice President's Report:**

- Hot Lunch Updates
  - Made aware of some nutritional changes for the concessions program at the high school. We will also streamline the lunch program menu offerings at the JHHS to increase efficiency and provide more nutritional selections.

### **President's Report:**

- Gil reviewed the Disbursement Request and Approval Process
  - Thank you note for Lisa Marinelli's (K-12 ESL) white board.

#### **Disbursement Approvals & Requests:**

- White Board (ES ESL- Marinelli)
- White Board (Second Grade Powers)
- ESports (Dent)
  - Gil reviewed how DJ is bringing back the E-Sports Club
    - They are part of a competitive E-Sports league
      - Students will compete every Thursday, practices are Wednesday

- Original Ask was \$1282 to impact 7 students currently in club. Gil spoke with DJ, Ben, and previous Board Members
  - Jennifer Tremblay and Tom Timmers spoke on behalf of e-Sports,
    DJ was not present
  - Ben mentioned that this is a school sponsored event
    - It is about teamwork, building teamwork, etc.
    - Jennifer asked how do clubs start or get seed funding?
      - Ben mentioned that startup funding is typically the responsibility of the parents and students
  - Tom Timmers motioned to approve amount of \$1282
  - Denay Knope seconded the motion
  - All in Favor: 8
  - All Opposed: 6 All Board Members voted opposed to the full funding amount. Board was in favor of providing \$600 in funding.
    - Motion Passed to fund \$1282

  - Melinda Davis OHMTA Treasurer
    - Band came to OHMTA with a request for new chairs
      - Chairs were originally purchased in 1990
      - This will be a multi-support org funding request.
