



William W. Gaulty	
William W. Gaulty, of Winchester, MA, formerly of W. Hartford, beloved husband of Mollie Lisberger Gaulty, died Tuesday, (May 22, 2001). Born in Troy, NY, on Dec. 30, 1923, he was a U.S. Navy veteran of World II, and a graduate of Dartmouth College, Class of 1946, and Harvard Law School, Class of 1951. He worked for the Connecticut Bank & Trust Co. for several years, and was named head of the Trust Division in 1966. In 1976, he opened his own law firm in West Hartford,	

where he worked for over 20 years. He was active in the community as past President of the American Bankers Assoc. Trust Division; a 20-year member of the Board of Trustees of Plimoth Plantation in Massachusetts, where he was Chairman of the Endowment Fund; past President of the Board of Trustees of the Renbrook School in W. Hartford; and also served as Trustee of several other charitable foundations. He was a devoted father to William W., Jr. of W. Stockbridge, MA, Colton of Wichita Falls, TX, Susan Kelleher of Cromwell, Martha Berntsen of Port Chester, NY, Henry of Niantic, and Roger of Chanhassen, MN. He is also survived by 21 grandchildren. A Memorial Service will be held at the Parish of the Epiphany, 70 Church St., Winchester, MA, on Wednesday, May 30, at 1 p.m. Relatives and friends are respectfully invited.
