Test Checklist

Preparation

1. Arrive 15 minutes early or more before each section
2. Make sure pens, all packets, phones with stopwatch apps are ready.
3. Make sure water is ready.
4. Make sure your personal electronic devices are in silence mode.

Things to Keep in Mind

After each task there will be a small questionnaire and some time for questions and comments as we set up the next task scenario.

Remember that there are no wrong answers and we are not testing **you**, only the product, we did not create the website in question and want your honest feedback.

Post-Study Interview Scripts(3 min: Questions about your experience and your opinions of this site.)

“Now that you have explored this website I would like to ask you some questions about your experience and opinions of it.”

1. What is your thoughts on the purpose of this website?
2. What advantages and disadvantages did you find when using this website?
3. How would you describe your overall experience using this website?
4. What did you like or dislike about the site?

Conclusion Script (2 min: ask observation team to see if they have any questions, if they do ask those questions...)

“Thank you for coming in and taking the time to be part of our study. Do you have any questions?” [Collect participant packet]
