This assessment instrument was administered last Wednesday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The students were covering the fourth and last skill of the Teacher Work Sample; the writing process. As planned, the students began studying the concepts and steps of the writing process, completing various exercises in class both individually and in whole group discussions. Special projects were also part of their tasks but before fulfilling the final word, they had to be evaluated in regards of their dominance and understanding of the concept and skills being taught. This assessment was conducted in the classroom and is composed of three parts. First, the students had a True or False exercise where the items were the definitions of the steps of the writing process. In the second part, students had to match each step with its translation to Spanish and at the end, they had to write the five steps in the order learned in class. *What happens? Follow instructions*

Above are two students who are totally opposite. The successful assessment pertains to a student who is partially bilingual, has good studying habits and presents interest in the class. The failed assessment is a student who has not yet found interest strong enough to learn English as a second language. Participation in class is very little and studying habits are not part of her daily life. During the teaching of this skill, students grasped the concepts very quickly and firmly. Various activities were practiced, and the topic was covered for seven days.

The chart below shows the analysis of data obtained after applying the evaluation instrument. A total of sixty-four percent of the students showed a dominance of the skills being taught and evaluated. In real numbers, fourteen students out of eighteen successfully accomplished the goals of the topic from the thematic unit. Only thirty-five percent of the group failed to meet the PCRS expectations. A more than satisfactory total of eight A's was collected, and in general, 366 points were generated from this assessment.
