**Position Overview:** An Enjoyco therapist will provide outpatient individual therapy to clients. Therapy services include treatment of children, adolescents, adults, couples and families. We are currently looking for therapists or counselors who work with teens and adults ages 13+, who are goal-oriented, purpose-driven, and ready to be a part of a dynamic, fun, and collaborative team. ### **Duties/Responsibilities:**

- Perform in-person and telehealth clinical counseling services via our secure HIPAA-compliant platform to clients of Enjoyco, as scheduled, and in accordance with company policies.
- Update your calendar and availability as needed.
- Regular and reliable attendance and timely arrival to work is required.
- Be properly licensed and abide by all laws, rules, regulations, and codes of ethics that are binding upon or applicable to the services performed for Enjoyco.
- Respond to client's requests for within 24 hours whether such requests are made in person, by phone, voicemail, etc. or through the Enjoyco website. Respond to such requests by meeting, evaluating, and providing services to such clients.
- Communicate with a client's treatment team (i.e., PCP, psychiatrist, school, etc.) as necessary.
- Timely complete written records for each patient including, but not limited to: intake notes, progress notes, treatment plans, termination notes, contract notes, and other forms or documents which may be needed or required from time-to-time by Enjoyco or third parties in conjunction with the treatment of the client within a timely fashion (by Friday of each week). Keep patient files accurate and up to date.

- Attend mandatory staff meetings and training.
- Actively engaging in community resource building and referral sources to build a caseload alongside our marketing.
- Passion for working with others (being collaborative) and helping our team members grow and learn.
- Other duties as may be assigned.

#### **Qualifications and Skills:**

- Align with Enjoyco mission, vision, and values.
- Must be punctual in reporting to work.
- Master's Degree or higher in counseling or social work
- Active, unrestricted license (PhD, PsyD, LCSW, LMFT, LPC-MHSP or LPC) in the State of Tennessee (must be fully licensed or have their Temporary License). A copy must be provided to Enjoyco.
- Available to hold *at least* 18 patient sessions per week, provided such sessions are available and referred/scheduled by Enjoyco.
- Be organized and detail oriented.
- Be a team player.
- Be able to work independently on tasks assigned.
- Consistently display strong interpersonal and verbal and written communication skills, including the ability to professionally communicate to clients, colleagues, management, and community resources/connections.
- Prior experience in a private practice setting is highly preferred.
- Prior experience running groups or workshops is preferred, but not required.
- At least one year experience post-unrestricted licensure.
- Have at least one niche market for counseling services (i.e., teens, trauma, anxiety, grief, anger management, etc.).
- EMDR certification is a bonus, but not required.
