

## 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl when YHWH appears to Job

We continue with our study in Job with an important discovery of the 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl. This channel is all about studying the book of Revelation with hopes of achieving accurate interpretations. Interpretations come by comparing scripture with scripture as the Holy Spirit has already laid out the understanding of Revelation in other passages, thereby encoding interpretation.

The mystery in Job is the when Aleph Tav appears to Job, He does so in the context of the 6<sup>th</sup> Seal, 7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet and 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl all converging into one event! For example, we'll see the context of each in this study key words, **Bowl** = as the vision of a vessel? (Job 37:18, ABP), **Trumpet** = whenever the trumpet signifies and with the trumpet signifying, he (horse) says, Well done! 39:24-25; **Seal** = It is turned as clay to the seal 38:14. When we see elements of the 6<sup>th</sup> Seal, 7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet and 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl in chapters 38 through 41 in a single event, we interpret that as meaning the Son of Man appearing in the clouds happened to Job and will fulfill many prophecies at once!

For context, here's the 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl in Rev 16:

And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet - Rev 11 And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever... And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldst give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldst destroy them which destroy the earth. And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

- **End of Two Witnesses Testimony:**

In Rev 11: 7 when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

In our next message, we see Eliyahu, which Hebrew pronunciation for Elijah, who finishes his discourse from Job 32 to 37, then 38:1 ABP “And after the ceasing of the speech of Elihu, the Lord said to Job through a tempest and cloud,...” So, here the completion of Eliyahu’s speech marks the ending of the Two Witnesses Testimony after which the 7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet is blown.

- **Ark of the Covenant:**

The Ark as mentioned in these events is seen in [Job 38:38](#), “and I have cleaved it as a stone cube?” in Greek is kubon κύβον G2942.1 and in [Esther 1:6](#) κύβοις - where we get in English cube. This relates to His "Step" Purple Footstool G1912.1 in SS 3:7 and Ps 104:3 “placing clouds for his step; the one walking upon the wings of the winds.” Thus, we believe, this “cube” and “step” are his footstool of which the mystery of the Ark is represented.

- **Cornerstone of Temple:**

There in Rev 11 “there was seen in his **temple**” and in Rev 16 the “there came a great voice out of the **temple** of heaven, from the throne.” Christ being the chief cornerstone of the Temple is mentioned in Job 38:6 “who laid the corner stone thereof” or Angular stone in ABP γωνιαίον - an angular G1137.1 cornerstone.

- **Hail and Ice:**

Hail and Ice are seen as a major sign of the 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl and Trumpet as well as Armageddon.

Job 38:22-23 ABP ...and have you seen the treasuries of **hail**? 23. And is it reserved to you for the **hour** of the enemies, for the day of war and battle?

Elements of Gog Magog Ezk 38:22 I will rain upon him, and upon his bands, and upon the many people that are with him, an overflowing rain, and great **hailstones**, fire, and brimstone.

Job 38:29-30 ABP ...And from out of whose womb comes forth the **ice**; and who gave birth to the frost in the heaven, 30. which comes down as if water flowing?... Ice is κρύσταλλος krystallos crystal g2930 or קְרָהֶּ qerah; h7140 ice, hail; by resemblance, rock crystal:

We also have Ice G3803.1 in Job 37:10 By the breath of God frost πάγος - this ice is also in Zechariah 14:6 πάγος - ice, "it will be in that day there shall not be light; and chilliness and **ice**." "That Day" in Zech 14 is when "He stands on Mt Olives."

Chilliness g5592 ψύχος psýchos, psou'-khos there in Zech 14:6 is also in Job 37:9

- **It is Done**

"There came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, **It is done**. When we look for "It is Done" done in Job it's the White Horse saying, "Well Done" with voice of a trumpet, Job 39:25 ABP "with the trumpet signifying, he says, Well done!" G2103.1 euge εύγε - Well done! Relates to what the Father said of Christ εὐδοκέω eudokeō g2106 "this is My Son in whom I am well pleased εὐδοκέω eudokeo."

- **keys of hell and of death**

In Rev 1:18 Christ provides insight into when he went to the underworld to preach the gospel to pre-flood souls when He said, "I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell ἄδης hadēs and of death θάνατος thanatos."

1 Pet 3:19 By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison; Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah. 4:6 the gospel was preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.

16. Did you come unto the spring of the sea, and walk in the tracks of the deep ἄβυσσος abyssos? 17. And do the gates πύλη pyle of death θάνατος thanatos open to you in fear; and did gatekeepers G4440.1 πυλωροί of Hades, in beholding you, become alarmed? (Job 38:16-17, ABP)

Job 38:30-31 ABP ...And who alarmed the face of the abyss?

Mat 16:18 ABP I will build my assembly, and the gates πύλη pylē of Hades shall not prevail against it.

- **Earthquake**

If major signs of the 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl, the Hail, "It is Done" are there, the Earthquake σεισμός seismós should also be seen, in which Job 41:29 indicates '...he ridicules the quaking σεισμός seismós of a fire-bearer"

The Earthquake is also implied in Job 38:13 "That it might take hold of the ends of the earth, that the wicked might be shaken out of it?"

- **Behemoth and Leviathan judged**

The Beasts being judged the same day? 2 Thes 2 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: Behemoth Job 40:19 he that made him can make his sword to approach unto him.

Gog Ezk 38 And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth,

Job 41:1 Canst thou draw out leviathan with a hook? Canst thou put an hook into his nose?

- **7<sup>th</sup> Thunder**

What we believe is that 4 times KJV uses the word thunder and each an aspect of the 7<sup>th</sup> Thunder, whether before the throne, the white horse of the 4 captains.

Job 38:25 a way for the lightning of thunder; Job 39:19 hast thou clothed his (white horse) neck with thunder? v25 He saith among the trumpets, Ha, ha; and he smelleth the battle afar off, the thunder of the captains, and the shouting. Job 40:9, ABP do you thunder with a voice as His?

- **White Horse**

White Horse 39:18-25. And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse Rev 19:11

Job 39:19-25 ABP Or did you invest the horse with power, or clothe his neck in fear? 20. And did you invest in him full armor, and the glory of his breast in daring? 21. He prances rooting up in the plain, and he goes forth into the plain in strength. 22. He ridicules meeting up with spears, and in no way turns from an iron weapon. 23. Against him prance the bow and sword; 24. and in anger he shall obliterate the ground. In no way shall he trust until whenever the trumpet signifies; 25. and with the trumpet signifying, he says, Well done! And at a distance he smells war with leaping and crying out.

- **Garments of Praise**

And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigns. Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. Rev 19 worship.

Job 38:7 When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? or ABP When the stars came to pass, all My angels praised me with a great voice

Harp nebel who can stay the bottles (psaltery) of heaven, 38:37

Job 37:17 How thy garments are warm, 38:6 When I made the cloud the garment thereof, and thick darkness a swaddlingband for it v14 and they stand as a garment.
