

**Maintenance Stonemason
A33****JCC 8244/Range****Responsibilities:**

Working under general supervision, these employees perform a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks involving stonemasonry, mosaic and roofing tile setting, plastering, and related work.

The supervisor schedules work and makes assignments in terms of results to be achieved. The stonemason carries out the work independently, taking to his supervisor only the most difficult problems and problems related to the supply of materials.

Characteristic Duties:

- Repairs stone structures, such as arches, by removing old stones, cutting and shaping new stones to match stones removed, and installing new stones
- Lays roofing tile to repair roofs
- Repairs decorative mosaic panels by removing old sections, preparing new matching sections, and laying the new portions
- Repairs plaster in walls
- Uses a variety of hand tools, such as mallets, chisels, facing hammers, calipers, compasses, straightedges, squares, punches, hammers and tile setters
- May oversee the work of a laborer assigned to assist him.

Qualifications:

These employees must be skilled in the use of tools, materials and methods of the stonemasonry trade. They must have sufficient experience to qualify as a Journeyman Stonemason, with approximately four years of actual work in the trade. This may include time spent in apprenticeship or vocational training
