Instructions:

Staff should use the *Primary Evidence, Guideline, and Policy Sources - Research Worksheet* to guide and document a systematic search of core evidence, guideline, and policy sources.

- When topics are initially identified, staff will use the Research Worksheet to document a preliminary search of the topic for purposes of Benefit Selection and Prioritization (i.e. completing a Benefit Referral form). This preliminary search should focus on a selection of sources, including:
 - Table 1 (general context, current Louisiana Medicaid policy)
 - Table 3 (clinical guideline sources)
 - Table 4 (targeted search: Medicaid.gov or other relevant federal agencies; Medicare coverage database; BCBS)
- If benefits are selected for policy development, staff will use the *Research Worksheet* to complete a full evidence, guideline and policy search. Results from the full search will be used to develop a Benefit Referral Brief and inform the development of a coverage policy.
- Preliminary searches that are more than 2 months old at the time of the full evidence and policy search should be updated.
