... In the early 1900s deer populations in Arkansas began a steady decline because of unrestricted hunting and the clearing of habitat for farmland. By the 1920s the deer population had been reduced to perhaps 500. The state and federal governments set up refuges, which were critical for restoring deer populations. In 1944 Arkansas voters

Commissioners approved a major change that increases the statewidedeer bag limit from five to six deer with no more than two bucks. Another change eliminates the use of preference points for 2013-14 deer hunting permits. ...
