- 60% of our colleges have a food pantry or food closets

- Local partnership with farmer markets and farms- Tactic
- Community Garden available to the public- Tactic
- Food plan or food card for the canteen or cafe for students who need this service- Tactic
- Funding and education for the colleges into the food insecurity
- Look into Food Stamps and awareness for this cause
- Raise awareness into the programs for food insecurity
- Funding for each college is divided by the amount of full time students and the school decides how they use that money
