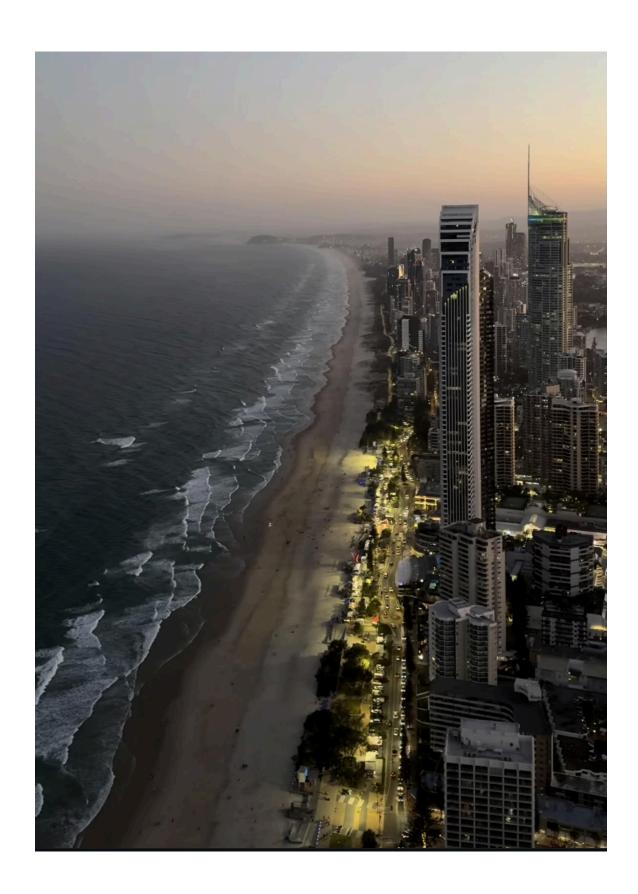

But every moment of the hustle, every hour spent working on my skills, feeds my drive to make it.

Physically, I'm disciplined. I train hard, and it shows in my workouts — eight pull-ups with 20kg of added weight and 40kg of weighted dips for reps. This regimen keeps me focused, though the confidence I project in the gym isn't always the same confidence I feel outside of it. The acne that's followed me for years is a barrier I'm working to break. It's held me back from relationships and from making the connections I want. But I know I can overcome this, just as I'm overcoming other challenges.

I have a long way to go in copywriting, and I don't pretend to know it all.
