Put your money where it will do the most good! The groups listed below will ensure your donation goes where it's most needed, whether you choose to support grassroots organizations, toss-up House and Senate races, or focus on State legislature, Secretaries of State and Attorneys General races.

If you want to donate directly to progressive candidates running for office in key battleground states, please go to our [Candidate Page](#) (use the state names to jump to competitive races in those states, then scroll down to find your candidate and click on "donate").

If you want to donate directly to candidates in the highest priority battleground states, first go to the Get Out The Vote Matrix ([GOTV Matrix](#)) where the states are listed in priority order (following WA State, which is always the most important). Pick a high priority state, then go to the [Candidate Page](#) to jump to that state. Scroll down to find the donate links for the candidates in the most competitive races in that state.

❖ [First Mile Circle](#)

- **Focus: Progressive people of color in down-ballot races in Washington State.** Everyone living in our democracy deserves to see themselves represented by it no matter what we look like or where we come from. Yet too many of our neighbors do not see their identities or needs represented by our government. This gap is evident in Washington state, where Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) communities make up more than 36% of Washington's population, yet only 19% of all our elected leaders are from these communities. BIPOC communities are underrepresented at every level of government in our state, from school boards to the legislature.

❖ Flip the Vote

- **Focus: Engaging voters in nine pivotal states to help win control of the US House and Senate in 2026 while building momentum to retake the White House in 2028.** We invest in [grassroots groups](#) working year round in their local communities to foster belonging, trust, and agency through meaningful civic engagement. They facilitate honest conversations about what's happening in our country and how to move toward a society that works for us all. These types of civic activities are key to **blocking authoritarianism and building democracy**.

❖ Focus for Democracy

- **Focus: We apply rigorous, metrics-based research to recommend programs that will have the highest impact for each dollar spent.** Our strategic analysis and evaluation allow you to feel confident about where your contributions will be most effective. The majority of our work is nonpartisan and aims to increase voter participation and provide nonpartisan voter education to the public, including our growing network of over 20,000 donors. For the partisan portion of our work, we first identify [key races critical to protecting our democracy](#). We then identify evidence-based programs with the potential to significantly impact those races.

❖ Force Multiplier

- **Focus: Toss-up House and Senate Races and support for grassroots organizations in battleground states.** Force Multiplier focuses our recommendations on targeted candidates and groups where we can all have collective impact. We rigorously research where your donations will matter most, continually tracking the political landscape and updating our recommendations as opportunities and threats arise.

❖ Movement Voter Proct

- **Focus: Support for grassroots partners in the most critical battleground races.** Movement Voter PAC funds local organizing and movement-building groups working to shift culture, win power, and shape policy. MVP operates like a “mutual fund” for political giving: We raise money from donors, then channel it toward the most impactful organizations and power-building work around the country.

❖ Oath

- **Focus: Oath empowers donors to give more strategically by making data-driven recommendations about where your dollars have maximum impact.** We analyze thousands of elections from President to school board to find which candidates need your support the most. We provide our recommendations for free and we don't sell or share your contact information. ❖ Swing Left

- **Focus: Help Democrats win the midterms in 2026.** Invest in the races that will break Republican control in Washington—chosen through rigorous analysis and where grassroots support can truly change the outcome. Five investment options: Balance of Power fund (win back majorities in Congress), Flip the House fund, Win the Senate fund, Win in the States fund, Support Ground Truth fund.

❖ Vote Save America

- **Focus: Vote Save America's (VSA) mission is to help build a movement that brings as many Americans as possible together not just to win on Election Day, but to fight every day in between for an America that honors basic freedoms, the rule of law, equality, and democracy itself.** Four different funds: The **Anxiety Relief** Program supports people impacted by Trump's policies, help progressive candidates, and fund essential VSA programs . **The House Fund** protects Democratic incumbents in tough reelection battles and gets Democratic challengers ready to beat vulnerable Republicans. ❖ Voters Participation Center

- **Focus: Increasing voter registration of the New American Majority (young people, people of color and unmarried women).** A non-profit, non-partisan organization that helps members of the New American

Majority register and vote. The organization has helped more than 6 million people register and cast ballots .
