- How to install Steam:

```
wget http://media.steampowered.com/client/installer/steam.deb -O /tmp/steam.deb
sudo dpkg -i /tmp/steam.deb
sudo apt-get install -f
```

- NOTE 1 - Graphic driver: https://wiki.ubuntu.com/Valve#Driver_Upgrades

NVIDIA Graphics -

In 12.04, launch the Additional Hardware Drivers dialog from System Settings.

In 12.10, launch Software Sources, then click on the Additional Drivers tab in the Software Sources menu.

Install the newest *nvidia-experimental-NNN* driver.

wget https://fpdownload.macromedia.com/get/flashplayer/pdc/11.2.202.406/install_flash_player_11_linux.i386.tar.gz -O /tmp/install_flash_player_11_linux.i386.tar.gz

mkdir -p \$HOME/.local/share/Steam/ubuntu12_32/plugins/

tar zxvf /tmp/install_flash_player_11_linux.i386.tar.gz -C \$HOME/.local/share/Steam/ubuntu12_32/plugins/ libflashplayer.so

sudo apt-get install libxt6:i386

If Flash videos still don't work, do this: (some old installations may still use this folder)

mkdir \$HOME/Steam/ubuntu12_32/plugins/

tar zxvf /tmp/install_flash_player_11_linux.i386.tar.gz -C \$HOME/Steam/ubuntu12_32/plugins/ libflashplayer.so
