

Splash Awards

Switzerland is in the process to set up a splash awards event. Need for established processes, shared tools to set this up in a stable manner (e.g. to be repeated each year). Bert Boerland (NL) mentions the possibility to share the codebase for a public version for splashawards website. Bart Vreugdenhil (NL) says NL is also in the process of setting up the next splash awards. The code for their site is being updated and will be public.

Nicoloye talks about the codebase shared from drupal.nl with France, and that they will contribute translate issues.

Pieter: the code from the drupal.nl is for an association, not for an event. It's a (cool) marketing site.

There is a practical problem to maintain websites, getting the time and people to do the updates and keep it up to date after an event.

- Tips: how to find people
 - o organize online meet-ups monthly (
 - o share recordings or do life streaming
 - getting participants to give presentations
 - or just gather and speak about drupal
 - ask companies to organize and host small talks (e.g. Drupal Tech Talks, Drupal User Group) (to promote themself, to keep the flow going)
 - Regular meetings are the key (free pizza will help).
- Tips: how to find topics/speakers
 - sharing experiences (doesn't have to be technical)

- asking companies to provide speakers (great for marketing, free advertising, opportunity for promotional video's etc). Give the companies guidelines (e.g. about food options)
- Codesharing by the Dutch Drupal Association. Right now, the code is being set up by France. The goal is to share it with more associations in the future. This website gives lots of space for companies (partners) to shine.
 - looking for a way to organize memberships through the website. Having people sign up, pay and be reminded. France is planning to develop something for this on top of the Dutch codebase, and if this works, will contribute to the codebase.
- Finances: The Dutch have a good financial situation because companies support them. This made it possible to outsource organizing memberships and to outsource the design and development of the website. In exchange, companies get chances to shine on the site, to get a badge, to go to a business dinner, etc.
- Promotion: The Dutch will have a radio commercial (and podcast) on the leading Business Radio channel about Drupal.
- Poland: would be happy to also share the codebase of drupalcamp.
